Present Participle	<b>alligating</b>
Past Participle	<b>alligated</b>

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **alligate**

We **alligate**

You **alligate**

You **alligate**

He/She/It **alligates**

They **alligate**

## **Alligate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am alligating**

We **are alligating**

You **are alligating**

You **are alligating**

He/She/It **is alligating**

They **are alligating**

## **Alligate in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have alligated**

We **have alligated**

You **have alligated**

You **have alligated**

He/She/It **has alligated**

They **have alligated**

## **Alligate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been alligating**

We **have been alligating**

You **have been alligating**

You **have been alligating**

He/She/It **has been alligating**

They **have been alligating**

## **Alligate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **alligated**

We **alligated**

You **alligated**

You **alligated**

He/She/It **alligated**

They **alligated**

## **Alligate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **was alligating**      We **were alligating**  
You **were alligating**      You **were alligating**  
He/She/It **was alligating**      They **were alligating**

**Alligate in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had alligated**      We **had alligated**  
You **had alligated**      You **had alligated**  
He/She/It **had alligated**      They **had alligated**

**Alligate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

I **had been alligating**      We **had been alligating**  
You **had been alligating**      You **had been alligating**  
He/She/It **had been alligating**      They **had been alligating**

**Alligate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

I **will alligate**      We **will alligate**  
You **will alligate**      You **will alligate**  
He/She/It **will alligate**      They **will alligate**

**Alligate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

I **will be alligating**      We **will be alligating**  
You **will be alligating**      You **will be alligating**  
He/She/It **will be alligating**      They **will be alligating**

**I will have alligated**

**We will have alligated**

**You will have alligated**

**You will have alligated**

**He/She/It will have alligated**

**They will have alligated**

**I will have been alligating**

**We will have been alligating**

**You will have been alligating**

**You will have been alligating**
