Alligator in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural
I alligator We alligator
You alligator You alligator
He/She/It alligators They alligator

Alligator in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am alligatoring We are alligatoring
You are alligatoring You are alligatoring
He/She/It is alligatoring They are alligatoring

Alligator in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have alligatored We have alligatored You have alligatored He/She/It has alligatored They have alligatored

Alligator in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been alligatoring
You have been alligatoring
He/She/It has been alligatoring
They have been alligatoring

Alligator in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I alligatored We alligatored
You alligatored You alligatored
He/She/It alligatored They alligatored

Alligator in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was alligatoring We were alligatoring
You were alligatoring You were alligatoring
He/She/It was alligatoring They were alligatoring

Alligator in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had alligatored We had alligatored
You had alligatored You had alligatored
He/She/It had alligatored They had alligatored

Alligator in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been alligatoring We had been alligatoring
You had been alligatoring You had been alligatoring
He/She/It had been alligatoring They had been alligatoring

Alligator in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will alligator
You will alligator
He/She/It will alligator They will alligator

Alligator in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be alligatoring
You will be alligatoring
He/She/It will be alligatoring
They will be alligatoring

Alligator in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have alligatored We will have alligatored You will have alligatored He/She/It will have alligatored They will have alligatored

Alligator in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been alligatoring
You will have been alligatoring
He/She/It will have been alligatoring
They will have been alligatoring
