Past Tense	<b>alligatored</b>
Present Participle	<b>alligatoring</b>
Past Participle	<b>alligatored</b>

He/She/It **alligators**      They **alligator**

**Alligator in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

I **am alligating**                      We **are alligating**  
You **are alligating**                    You **are alligating**  
He/She/It **is alligating**      They **are alligating**

**Alligator in Present Perfect Tense**

I **have alligated**                      We **have alligated**  
You **have alligated**                    You **have alligated**  
He/She/It **has alligated**      They **have alligated**

I **have been alligating**                      We **have been alligating**  
You **have been alligating**                    You **have been alligating**  
He/She/It **has been alligating**      They **have been alligating**
