across	From one side to the other of a place, area, etc. <i>19 across.</i>
chase	Cut a furrow into a columns. <i>The cost of the police time needed to chase up every new offence.</i>
come	Come to one s mind suggest itself. <i>Melons come from a vine.</i>
crisscross	Marked with crossing lines. <i>Crisscross the sheet of paper.</i>
ensue	Issue or terminate (in a specified way, state, etc.); end. <i>The difficulties which ensued from their commitment to Cuba.</i>
follow	Follow with the eyes or the mind. <i>She followed the men with the binoculars.</i>
intersect	Meet at a point. <i>The area is intersected only by minor roads.</i>
itinerary	A travel document recording a route or journey. <i>His itinerary included an official visit to Canada.</i>
lane	Each of a number of parallel strips of track or water for runners, rowers, or swimmers in a race. <i>She went into the final in lane three.</i>
listing	A list or catalogue.
pass	Pass over across or through. <i>They passed the amendment.</i>
passage	A narrow way allowing access between buildings or to different rooms within a building a passageway. <i>A neat passage of midfield play.</i>

path	A definition of the order in which an operating system or program searches for a file or executable program. <i>A vegetarian diet could be the path to a longer life.</i>
promenade	Take a promenade through a place. <i>An evening promenade.</i>
quest	(in medieval romance) an expedition made by a knight to accomplish a prescribed task. <i>The quest for a reliable vaccine has intensified.</i>
racetrack	A course over which races are run.
railroad	Supply with railroad lines. <i>His uncle works on the railroad.</i>
railway	A line of track providing a runway for wheels. <i>A railway line.</i>
retrace	Reassemble mentally. <i>I've tried to retrace some of her movements.</i>
road	A railroad. <i>They waited for a clear road at Hellifield Junction.</i>
route	Send via a specific route. <i>Proposals have been put forward for a new route around the south of the town.</i>
speeder	A driver who exceeds the safe speed limit.
station	The frequency assigned to a broadcasting station. <i>A radio station.</i>
succeed	Achieve the desired aim or result. <i>Keep trying and you will eventually succeed.</i>
trace	Discover traces of. <i>There wasn't a trace of evidence for the claim.</i>
track	Of wheels run so that the back ones are exactly in the track of the front ones. <i>The title track of the album.</i>
trail	A trailer for a film or broadcast. <i>Her voice trailed away.</i>
transit	Revolve the telescope of a surveying transit about its horizontal transverse axis in order to reverse its direction. <i>The comet will transit on September 11.</i>
traverse	An area of land surveyed with a traverse. <i>He traversed the forest.</i>
