<a href="#">across</a>	From one side to the other of a place, area, etc. <i>19 across.</i>
<b>chase</b>	Cut a furrow into a columns. <i>The cost of the police time needed to <b>chase</b> up every new offence.</i>
<b>come</b>	Come to one s mind suggest itself. <i>Melons <b>come</b> from a vine.</i>
<b>crisscross</b>	Marked with crossing lines. <i><b>Crisscross</b> the sheet of paper.</i>
<a href="#">ensue</a>	Issue or terminate (in a specified way, state, etc.); end. <i>The difficulties which <b>ensued</b> from their commitment to Cuba.</i>
<b>follow</b>	Follow with the eyes or the mind. <i>She <b>followed</b> the men with the binoculars.</i>
<b>intersect</b>	Meet at a point. <i>The area is <b>intersected</b> only by minor roads.</i>
<b>itinerary</b>	A travel document recording a route or journey. <i>His <b>itinerary</b> included an official visit to Canada.</i>
<b>lane</b>	Each of a number of parallel strips of track or water for runners, rowers, or swimmers in a race. <i>She went into the final in <b>lane</b> three.</i>
<b>listing</b>	A list or catalogue.
<b>pass</b>	Pass over across or through. <i>They <b>passed</b> the amendment.</i>
<a href="#">passage</a>	A narrow way allowing access between buildings or to different rooms within a building a passageway. <i>A neat <b>passage</b> of midfield play.</i>

<b>path</b>	A definition of the order in which an operating system or program searches for a file or executable program. <i>A vegetarian diet could be the <b>path</b> to a longer life.</i>
<b>promenade</b>	Take a promenade through a place. <i>An evening <b>promenade</b>.</i>
<b>quest</b>	(in medieval romance) an expedition made by a knight to accomplish a prescribed task. <i>The <b>quest</b> for a reliable vaccine has intensified.</i>
<b>racetrack</b>	A course over which races are run.
<b>railroad</b>	Supply with railroad lines. <i>His uncle works on the <b>railroad</b>.</i>
<b>railway</b>	A line of track providing a runway for wheels. <i>A <b>railway</b> line.</i>
<b>retrace</b>	Reassemble mentally. <i>I've tried to <b>retrace</b> some of her movements.</i>
<b>road</b>	A railroad. <i>They waited for a clear <b>road</b> at Hellifield Junction.</i>
<b>route</b>	Send via a specific route. <i>Proposals have been put forward for a new <b>route</b> around the south of the town.</i>
<b>speeder</b>	A driver who exceeds the safe speed limit.
<b>station</b>	The frequency assigned to a broadcasting station. <i>A radio <b>station</b>.</i>
<b>succeed</b>	Achieve the desired aim or result. <i>Keep trying and you will eventually <b>succeed</b>.</i>
<b>trace</b>	Discover traces of. <i>There wasn't a <b>trace</b> of evidence for the claim.</i>
<b>track</b>	Of wheels run so that the back ones are exactly in the track of the front ones. <i>The title <b>track</b> of the album.</i>
<b>trail</b>	A trailer for a film or broadcast. <i>Her voice <b>trailed</b> away.</i>
<b>transit</b>	Revolve the telescope of a surveying transit about its horizontal transverse axis in order to reverse its direction. <i>The comet will <b>transit</b> on September 11.</i>
<b>traverse</b>	An area of land surveyed with a traverse. <i>He <b>traversed</b> the forest.</i>
