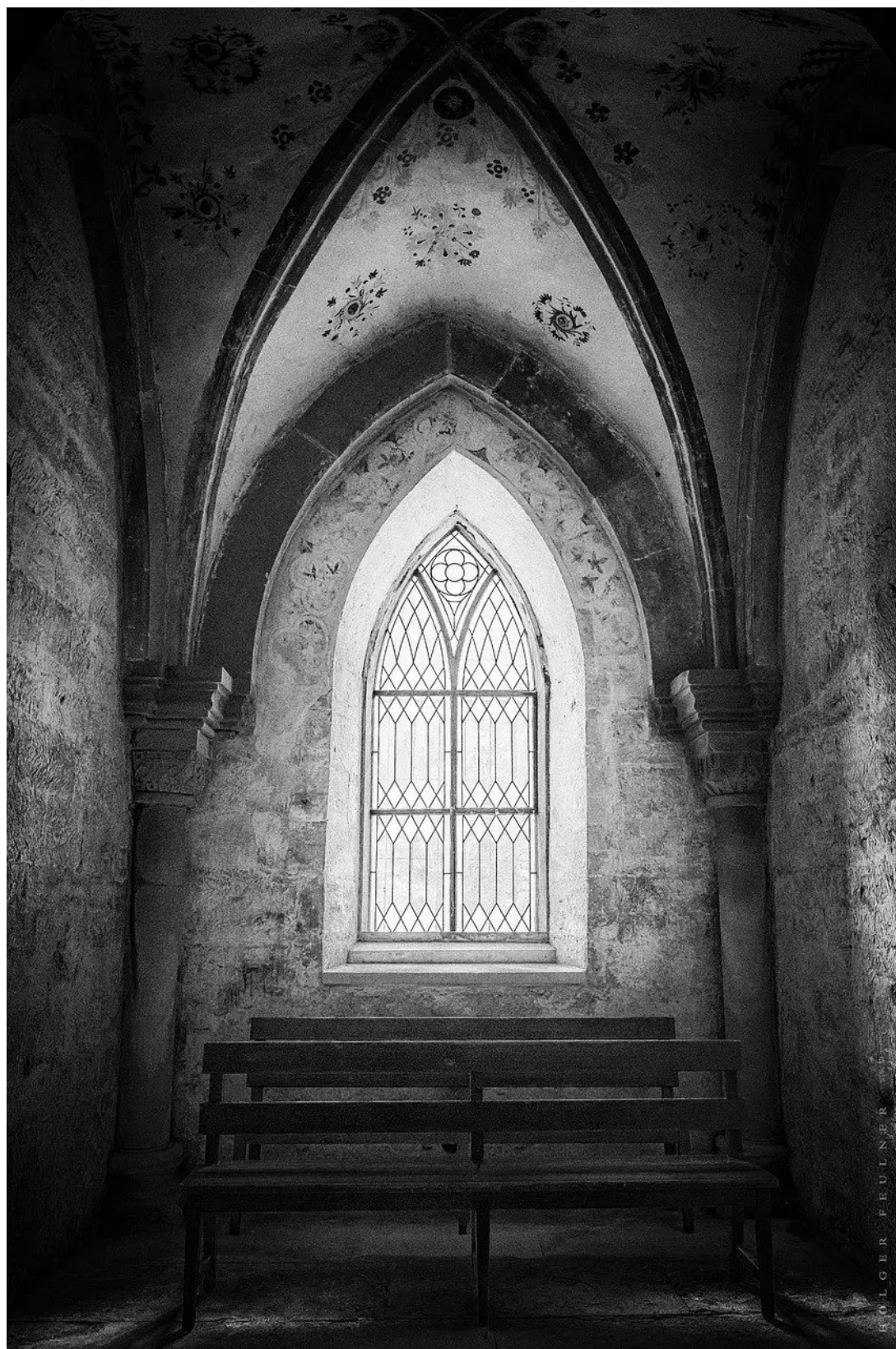

*They put their first batter **aboard**.*

**abreast** Alongside each other, facing in the same direction.  
*They were riding three **abreast**.*

[belated](#) After the expected or usual time; delayed.  
*A **belated** apology.*

[chic](#) Stylishness and elegance, typically of a specified kind.  
*The hotel's lobby and restaurant are the height of designer **chic**.*

**craze** Develop a fine network of cracks.  
*Internal stresses often caused the glue to **craze**.*

**current** Dominant course (suggestive of running water) of successive events or ideas.  
***Current** psychoanalytic theories.*

**currently** At the present time.  
*The EC is **currently** attempting greater economic integration.*

**fad** An interest followed with exaggerated zeal.  
*His **fads** about the type of coffee he must have.*

**faddish** Intensely fashionable or popular for a short period of time.  
*Tastes in flavoured coffee are so **faddish**.*

[fashionable](#) Popular and considered appealing or fashionable at the time.  
*A **fashionable** cafe.*

**informed** Having much knowledge or education.  
*Obtaining **informed** consent from research participants is central to ethical research practice.*

**lately** Recently; not long ago.  
***Lately** the rules have been enforced.*

**lateral** A lateral consonant.  
*The radius lies **lateral** to the ulna.*

[latest](#) The most recent news or development.  
*The very **latest** scientific discoveries.*

[modern](#) Belonging to the modern era since the Middle Ages.  
***Modern** German.*

<b>modish</b>	In the current fashion or style. <i>It seems sad that such a scholar should feel compelled to use this <b>modish</b> jargon.</i>
<b>newfangled</b>	Gratuitously new. <i><b>Newfangled</b> ideas.</i>
<b>newly</b>	Very recently. <i>Social confidence for the <b>newly</b> single.</i>
<b>next</b>	The next person or thing. <i><b>Next</b> I heard the sound of voices.</i>
<b>present</b>	Represent abstractly for example in a painting drawing or sculpture. <i><b>Present</b> at the creation.</i>
<b>presently</b>	At this time or period; now. <i>He is <b>presently</b> our ambassador to the United Nations.</i>
<b>recency</b>	The property of having happened or appeared not long ago.
<b>recent</b>	Approximately the last 10,000 years. <i>A <b>recent</b> edition of the newspaper.</i>
<b>recently</b>	At a recent time; not long ago. <i>I <b>recently</b> bought a CD player.</i>
<b>shortly</b>	In the near future. <i>To put it <b>shortly</b>.</i>
<b>soon</b>	Used to indicate one's preference in a particular matter. <i>How <b>soon</b> can you get here.</i>
<b>sophistication</b>	Falsification by the use of sophistry; misleading by means of specious fallacies. <i>Understanding affine transformations requires considerable mathematical <b>sophistication</b>.</i>
<b>stylish</b>	Neat, confident, and skilful. <i>A <b>stylish</b> cocktail bar.</i>
<b>up-to-date</b>	Sweet edible fruit of the date palm with a single long woody seed.
<b>urbanity</b>	Urban life. <i>There is an important difference between rusticity and <b>urbanity</b>.</i>
<b>whereabouts</b>	The place where someone or something is. <i><b>Whereabouts</b> do you come from.</i>
