<u>centered</u>	Being or placed in the center.
change	Money given in exchange for the same sum in larger units. <i>Passengers travelling to London will have to change trains in Bristol.</i>
changed	Changed in constitution or structure or composition by metamorphism. <i>Changed styles of dress.</i>

egoist	A self-centered person with little regard for others.
egotism	An exaggerated opinion of your own importance. <i>In his arrogance and egotism he underestimated Gill.</i>
egotist	A conceited and self-centered person. <i>He is a self absorbed egotist.</i>
individual	Characteristic of or meant for a single person or thing. <i>Individual tiny flowers.</i>
individualist	A person who pursues independent thought or action. <i>Individualist attitudes.</i>
<u>individualistic</u>	With minimally restricted freedom in commerce. <i>Individualistic cultures where individuals strive for self realization.</i>

	A mutant form.
mutant	<i>Frequently only a small percentage of the offspring of mutants resemble their parents.</i>
	The best state of something; the prime.
pride	<i>In the pride of youth.</i>
	Relating to of or by or to or from or for the self.
self	<i>An article with a picture of my good self.</i>
	Concerned chiefly or only with yourself and your advantage to the exclusion of others- Maria Weston Chapman.
selfish	<i>I joined them for selfish reasons.</i>
	The quality or state of being selfish; lack of consideration for other people.
selfishness	<i>An act of pure selfishness.</i>
	That part of the unconscious mind that acts as a conscience.
superego	<i>True schizophrenias lack the superego elements present in paranoia.</i>
	Elevate or idealize, in allusion to Christ's transfiguration.
transfigure	<i>The treatment and diet transfigured her into a beautiful young woman.</i>
	Subject to a mathematical transformation.
transform	<i>A wry cynicism rapidly transforms into an overwhelming sense of sourness.</i>
	A sudden dramatic change of scenery on stage.
transformation	<i>British society underwent a radical transformation.</i>
	Given a completely different form or appearance.
transformed	<i>Shocked to see the transformed landscape.</i>

transmogrify	<i>His home was transmogrified into a hippy crash pad.</i>
	Low table with mirror or mirrors where one sits while dressing or applying makeup.
vanity	<i>It flattered his vanity to think I was in love with him.</i>
	Characterized by variety.
varied	<i>Varied motives prompt people to join a political party.</i>
	Change from one condition, form, or state to another.
