# **Conjugate Amate**

### Amate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>amate</b>	We <b>amate</b>
You <b>amate</b>	You <b>amate</b>
He/She/It <b>amates</b>	They <b>amate</b>

### Amate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am amating	We are amating
You <b>are amating</b>	You <b>are amating</b>
He/She/It is amating	They are amating

### **Amate in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have amated	We have amated
You have amated	You have amated
He/She/It has amated	They have amated

### **Amate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been amating	We have been amating
You <b>have been amating</b>	You have been amating
He/She/It has been amating	They have been amating

### Amate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I amated	We <b>amated</b>
You <b>amated</b>	You <b>amated</b>
He/She/It <b>amated</b>	They <b>amated</b>

### Amate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was amating	We <b>were amating</b>
You were amating	You were amating
He/She/It was amating	They were amating

#### **Amate in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had amated	We had amated
You had amated	You had amated
He/She/It had amated	They had amated

### **Amate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been amating	We had been amating
You <b>had been amating</b>	You had been amating
He/She/It had been amating	They had been amating

### Amate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I <b>will amate</b>	We <b>will amate</b>
You <b>will amate</b>	You <b>will amate</b>
He/She/It will amate	They will amate

### Amate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be amating	We will be amating
You <b>will be amating</b>	You <b>will be amating</b>
He/She/It will be amating	They will be amating

#### **Amate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been amating	We <b>will have been amating</b>
You <b>will have been amating</b>	You will have been amating
He/She/It will have been amating	They will have been amating
