*The relaxed **ambience** of the cocktail lounge is popular with guests.*

**atmosphere** The air in any particular place.  
*An **atmosphere** of defeat pervaded the candidate's headquarters.*



## Associations of "Ambiance" (30 Words)

<b>acquiescence</b>	The reluctant acceptance of something without protest. <i>In silent <b>acquiescence</b> she rose to her feet.</i>
<b>amicable</b>	Characterized by friendliness and absence of discord. <i>An <b>amicable</b> agreement.</i>
<b>calm</b>	Become quiet or calm especially after a state of agitation. <i>The night was clear and <b>calm</b>.</i>
<b><u>calmness</u></b>	The state or quality of being free from agitation or strong emotion. <i>This relative <b>calmness</b> ended at around 7 a m when the wind picked up speed.</i>
<b>composed</b>	Serenely self-possessed and free from agitation especially in times of stress. <i>The performer seemed completely <b>composed</b> as she stepped onto the stage.</i>
<b>halcyon</b>	Marked by peace and prosperity. <i>The <b>halcyon</b> days of the clipper trade.</i>
<b><u>hush</u></b>	Become quiet or still; fall silent. <i>He placed a finger before pursed lips to <b>hush</b> her.</i>
<b><u>idyllic</u></b>	Like an idyll; extremely happy, peaceful, or picturesque. <i>An <b>idyllic</b> spot for a picnic.</i>
<b><u>imperturbable</u></b>	Unable to be upset or excited; calm. <i>An <b>imperturbable</b> self possession.</i>
<b>noiseless</b>	Making no sound. <i>The cycle is a <b>noiseless</b> form of transport.</i>
<b>nonviolence</b>	Peaceful resistance to a government by fasting or refusing to cooperate.
<b>pacific</b>	A steam locomotive of 4-6-2 wheel arrangement. <i>A <b>pacific</b> gesture.</i>
<b>peace</b>	A treaty agreeing peace between warring states. <i>The <b>peace</b> of mind this insurance gives you.</i>
<b>peaceable</b>	Disposed to peace or of a peaceful nature. <i>An industrious <b>peaceable</b> people.</i>
<b>peaceful</b>	Peacefully resistant in response to injustice. <i>A far from <b>peaceful</b> Christmas.</i>
<b>peacetime</b>	A period when a country is not at war. <i>In <b>peacetime</b> regiments were billeted upon towns and villages.</i>

<b><u>placid</u></b>	Calm and peaceful, with little movement or activity. <i>The <b>placid</b> waters of a small lake.</i>
<b><u>pleasant</u></b>	Having pleasing manners or behavior. <i>They found him <b>pleasant</b> and cooperative.</i>
<b>quietude</b>	A state of stillness, calmness, and quiet in a person or place. <i>It highlights her <b>quietude</b> and wise passivity.</i>
<b>relaxing</b>	Affording physical or mental rest. <i>A <b>relaxing</b> massage with aromatherapy oils.</i>
<b><u>restful</u></b>	Affording physical or mental rest. <i>The rooms were cool and <b>restful</b>.</i>
<b>reticence</b>	The quality of being reticent; reserve. <i>The traditional emotional <b>reticence</b> of the British.</i>
<b><u>serene</u></b>	An expanse of clear sky or calm sea. <i><b>Serene</b> certainty.</i>
<b><u>serenity</u></b>	The absence of mental stress or anxiety. <i>An oasis of <b>serenity</b> amidst the bustling city.</i>
<b>silence</b>	Keep from expression, for example by threats or pressure. <i>She <b>silenced</b> the alarm on her phone.</i>
<b><u>stillness</u></b>	A state of no motion or movement. <i>Absolute <b>stillness</b> greeted our gaze.</i>
<b><u>tranquil</u></b>	Free from disturbance by heavy waves. <i>The sea was <b>tranquil</b>.</i>
<b><u>tranquility</u></b>	A state of peace and quiet.
<b>tranquillity</b>	An untroubled state; free from disturbances. <i>Passing cars are the only noise that disturbs the <b>tranquillity</b> of rural life.</i>
<b>unflappable</b>	Having or showing calmness in a crisis. <i><b>Unflappable</b> in a crisis.</i>
