

Serenely self-possessed and free from agitation especially in times of

stress.

halcyon Marked by peace and prosperity.

A state of no motion or movement. **stillness**

Free from disturbance by heavy waves.

tranguil The sea was **tranquil**.

A state of peace and quiet. **tranquility**

An untroubled state; free from disturbances. tranquillity

Passing cars are the only noise that disturbs the **tranquillity** of rural life.

Having or showing calmness in a crisis.

unflappable **Unflappable** in a crisis.
