ambience The character and atmosphere of a place.
*The relaxed **ambience** of the cocktail lounge is popular with guests.*

atmosphere The air in any particular place.
*An **atmosphere** of defeat pervaded the candidate's headquarters.*

acquiescence	The reluctant acceptance of something without protest. <i>In silent acquiescence she rose to her feet.</i>
amicable	Characterized by friendliness and absence of discord. <i>An amicable agreement.</i>
calm	Become quiet or calm especially after a state of agitation. <i>The night was clear and calm.</i>
<u>calmness</u>	The state or quality of being free from agitation or strong emotion. <i>This relative calmness ended at around 7 a m when the wind picked up speed.</i>
composed	Serenely self-possessed and free from agitation especially in times of stress. <i>The performer seemed completely composed as she stepped onto the stage.</i>
halcyon	Marked by peace and prosperity. <i>The halcyon days of the clipper trade.</i>
<u>hush</u>	Become quiet or still; fall silent. <i>He placed a finger before pursed lips to hush her.</i>
<u>idyllic</u>	Like an idyll; extremely happy, peaceful, or picturesque. <i>An idyllic spot for a picnic.</i>
<u>imperturbable</u>	Unable to be upset or excited; calm. <i>An imperturbable self possession.</i>
noiseless	Making no sound. <i>The cycle is a noiseless form of transport.</i>
nonviolence	Peaceful resistance to a government by fasting or refusing to cooperate.
pacific	A steam locomotive of 4-6-2 wheel arrangement. <i>A pacific gesture.</i>
peace	A treaty agreeing peace between warring states. <i>The peace of mind this insurance gives you.</i>
peaceable	Disposed to peace or of a peaceful nature. <i>An industrious peaceable people.</i>
peaceful	Peacefully resistant in response to injustice. <i>A far from peaceful Christmas.</i>
peacetime	A period when a country is not at war. <i>In peacetime regiments were billeted upon towns and villages.</i>

<u>placid</u>	Calm and peaceful, with little movement or activity. <i>The placid waters of a small lake.</i>
<u>pleasant</u>	Having pleasing manners or behavior. <i>They found him pleasant and cooperative.</i>
quietude	A state of stillness, calmness, and quiet in a person or place. <i>It highlights her quietude and wise passivity.</i>
relaxing	Affording physical or mental rest. <i>A relaxing massage with aromatherapy oils.</i>
<u>restful</u>	Affording physical or mental rest. <i>The rooms were cool and restful.</i>
reticence	The quality of being reticent; reserve. <i>The traditional emotional reticence of the British.</i>
<u>serene</u>	An expanse of clear sky or calm sea. <i>Serene certainty.</i>
<u>serenity</u>	The absence of mental stress or anxiety. <i>An oasis of serenity amidst the bustling city.</i>
silence	Keep from expression, for example by threats or pressure. <i>She silenced the alarm on her phone.</i>
<u>stillness</u>	A state of no motion or movement. <i>Absolute stillness greeted our gaze.</i>
<u>tranquil</u>	Free from disturbance by heavy waves. <i>The sea was tranquil.</i>
<u>tranquility</u>	A state of peace and quiet.
tranquillity	An untroubled state; free from disturbances. <i>Passing cars are the only noise that disturbs the tranquillity of rural life.</i>
unflappable	Having or showing calmness in a crisis. <i>Unflappable in a crisis.</i>
