- *Quality or character given to a sound recording by the space in which the sound occurs.*
- *A particular environment or surrounding influence.*



Synonyms of "Ambience" as a noun (18 Words)

air	Referring to the use of aircraft. <i>The doctor told me to get some fresh air.</i>
<u>ambiance</u>	A particular environment or surrounding influence.
atmosphere	The air in any particular place. <i>The hotel has won commendations for its friendly welcoming atmosphere.</i>
<u>aura</u>	The distinctive atmosphere or quality that seems to surround and be generated by a person, thing, or place. <i>Emotional mental and spiritual levels form an energy field around the body known as the aura.</i>
character	A characteristic especially one that assists in the identification of a species. <i>The Greek alphabet has 24 characters.</i>
<u>climate</u>	A region with a particular climate. <i>The current economic climate.</i>
complexion	The natural colour, texture, and appearance of a person's skin, especially of the face. <i>A smooth pale complexion.</i>
<u>echo</u>	A close parallel to an idea, feeling, or event. <i>His love for her found an echo in her own feelings.</i>
feel	Feelings of heightened emotion. <i>It s easy when you get the feel of it.</i>
feeling	An attitude or opinion. <i>What are your feelings about the crisis.</i>
flavour	A substance used to alter or enhance the taste of food or drink a flavouring. <i>The extracts give a flavour of the content and tone of the conversation.</i>
<u>impression</u>	An impressionistic portrayal of a person. <i>His first impressions of Manchester were very positive.</i>
look	An expression of a feeling or thought by looking. <i>The government should take a look at the amount of grant the council receives.</i>
mood	An angry, irritable, or sullen state of mind. <i>A concept album which captures the mood of modern times.</i>
quality	An essential and distinguishing attribute of something or someone-Shakespeare. <i>These colleges provide a better quality of education.</i>

spirit The non-physical part of a person which is the seat of emotions and character; the soul.

*He was in good **spirits**.*

tenor An adult male with a tenor voice.

*Several members of the party had been able to put in the **tenor** and the bass.*

tone A musical interval of two semitones.

*A reduction of muscle **tone**.*

- *The relaxed ambience of the cocktail lounge is popular with guests.*



Associations of "Ambience" (30 Words)

acquiescence	Acceptance without protest. <i>A murmur of acquiescence from the assembly.</i>
amicable	Characterized by friendship and good will. <i>An amicable settlement of the dispute.</i>
calm	Cause to be calm or quiet as by administering a sedative to. <i>A dead calm sea.</i>
<u>calmness</u>	The state or quality of being free from agitation or strong emotion. <i>This relative calmness ended at around 7 a m when the wind picked up speed.</i>
composed	Serenely self-possessed and free from agitation especially in times of stress. <i>The performer seemed completely composed as she stepped onto the stage.</i>
halcyon	Denoting a period of time in the past that was idyllically happy and peaceful. <i>A halcyon atmosphere.</i>
<u>hush</u>	Run water over the ground to erode (soil), revealing the underlying strata and valuable minerals. <i>Hush my baby.</i>
<u>idyllic</u>	Suggestive of an idyll; charmingly simple and serene. <i>His idyllic life in Tahiti.</i>
<u>imperturbable</u>	Unable to be upset or excited; calm. <i>Hitherto imperturbable he now showed signs of alarm.</i>
noiseless	Making no sound- Shakespeare. <i>The 4000 1 and 4000 2 use an adaptive noiseless data algorithm to compress data in real time.</i>
nonviolence	Peaceful resistance to a government by fasting or refusing to cooperate.
pacific	Relating to the Pacific Ocean. <i>A pacific gesture.</i>
peace	A treaty agreeing peace between warring states. <i>The 8 8 per cent offer promises peace with the union.</i>
peaceable	Inclined to avoid conflict or dissent. <i>Peaceable demonstrations for democratic reform.</i>
peaceful	Peacefully resistant in response to injustice. <i>His peaceful mood vanished.</i>

peacetime	A period of time during which there is no war. <i>In peacetime regiments were billeted upon towns and villages.</i>
placid	Free from disturbance by heavy waves. <i>Not everyone shared his placid temperament.</i>
pleasant	(of persons) having pleasing manners or behavior. <i>Pleasant sensations.</i>
quietude	A state of peace and quiet. <i>It highlights her quietude and wise passivity.</i>
relaxing	Reducing tension or anxiety. <i>A relaxing massage with aromatherapy oils.</i>
restful	Affording physical or mental rest. <i>She spent a restful night at home.</i>
reticence	The quality of being reticent; reserve. <i>The traditional emotional reticence of the British.</i>
serene	An expanse of clear sky or calm sea. <i>A serene expression on her face.</i>
serenity	A title given to a reigning prince or similar dignitary. <i>An oasis of serenity amidst the bustling city.</i>
silence	Stop or suppress (a sound or noise); cause to become silent. <i>The game was preceded by a two minute silence in his memory.</i>
stillness	(poetic) tranquil silence. <i>Absolute stillness greeted our gaze.</i>
tranquil	Free from disturbance by heavy waves. <i>A lake of tranquil blue water reflecting a tranquil blue sky.</i>
tranquility	A state of peace and quiet.
tranquillity	A state of peace and quiet. <i>Passing cars are the only noise that disturbs the tranquillity of rural life.</i>
unflappable	Not easily perturbed or excited or upset; marked by extreme calm and composure. <i>Unflappable in a crisis.</i>
