Ambiguate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I ambiguate	We ambiguate
You ambiguate	You ambiguate
He/She/It ambiguates	They ambiguate

Ambiguate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am ambiguating	We are ambiguating
You are ambiguating	You are ambiguating
He/She/It is ambiguating	They are ambiguating

Ambiguate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have ambiguated	We have ambiguated
You have ambiguated	You have ambiguated
He/She/It has ambiguated	They have ambiguated

Ambiguate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been ambiguating	We have been ambiguating
You have been ambiguating	You have been ambiguating
He/She/It has been ambiguating	They have been ambiguating

Ambiguate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I ambiguated	We ambiguated
You ambiguated	You ambiguated
He/She/It ambiguated	They ambiguated

Ambiguate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was ambiguating	We were ambiguating
You were ambiguating	You were ambiguating
He/She/It was ambiguating	They were ambiguating

Ambiguate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had ambiguated	We had ambiguated
You had ambiguated	You had ambiguated
He/She/It had ambiguated	They had ambiguated

Ambiguate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been ambiguating	We had been ambiguating
You had been ambiguating	You had been ambiguating
He/She/It had been ambiguating	They had been ambiguating

Ambiguate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will ambiguate	We will ambiguate
You will ambiguate	You will ambiguate
He/She/It will ambiguate	They will ambiguate

Ambiguate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

I will be ambiguating	We will be ambiguating
You will be ambiguating	You will be ambiguating
He/She/It will be ambiguating	They will be ambiguating
