- *Wildly; without self-control.*
- *In a murderous frenzy.*



## Synonyms of "Amok" as an adverb (2 Words)

- amuck** Wildly; without self-control.  
*Rioters running **amuck** and throwing sticks and bottles and stones.*
- murderously** As if bent on murder.

## Associations of "Amok" (30 Words)

- berserk** Frenzied as if possessed by a demon.  
*A **berserk** worker smashing windows.*
- bipolar** Of a person suffering from bipolar disorder.  
*A sharply **bipolar** division of affluent and underclass.*
- certifiable** Able or needing to be officially recorded.  
*Encephalitis was a **certifiable** condition.*

<b>crazy</b>	(of a ship or building) full of cracks or flaws; unsound. <i>The noise was driving me <b>crazy</b>.</i>
<b>demented</b>	Suffering from dementia. <i>She was <b>demented</b> with worry.</i>
<b>demoniac</b>	Relating to or characteristic of a demon or demons. <i><b>Demoniac</b> rage.</i>
<b><u>deranged</u></b>	Driven insane. <i>A <b>deranged</b> gunman.</i>
<b>disturbed</b>	Affected with madness or insanity. <i><b>Disturbed</b> grass showed where the horse had passed.</i>
<b>folly</b>	A theatrical revue with glamorous female performers. <i>An act of sheer <b>folly</b>.</i>
<b>foolery</b>	Foolish or senseless behavior. <i>We endured his <b>foolery</b> all afternoon.</i>
<b>harebrained</b>	Very foolish. <i><b>Harebrained</b> ideas.</i>
<b><u>insane</u></b>	Extremely foolish; irrational. <i>They were making <b>insane</b> amounts of money.</i>
<b><u>insanity</u></b>	Relatively permanent disorder of the mind. <i>It might be pure <b>insanity</b> to take this loan.</i>
<b>loon</b>	A silly or foolish person. <i>If only she weren't such a lovesick <b>loon</b>.</i>
<b>lunacy</b>	Foolish or senseless behavior. <i>It has been suggested that originality demands a degree of <b>lunacy</b>.</i>
<b><u>lunatic</u></b>	Extremely foolish or eccentric. <i>He would be asked to acquiesce in some <b>lunatic</b> scheme.</i>
<b>mad</b>	Make someone mad. <i>Antony's mother told him he was <b>mad</b> to be leaving Dublin.</i>
<b>madden</b>	Make (someone) extremely annoyed. <i>His behavior is <b>maddening</b>.</i>
<b>maniac</b>	An insane person. <i>A religious <b>maniac</b>.</i>
<b><u>maniacal</u></b>	Wildly disordered. <i>A <b>maniacal</b> frenzy.</i>
<b>mentally</b>	In a manner relating to the mind. <i>Soldiers become physically and <b>mentally</b> exhausted.</i>

<b>nuts</b>	Informal or slang terms for mentally irregular. <i>The way he turns on the television as soon as he walks in drives me <b>nuts</b>.</i>
<b><u>paranoid</u></b>	A person who is paranoid. <i>Further accusations would sound like the ramblings of a <b>paranoid</b>.</i>
<b>psychiatrist</b>	A medical practitioner specializing in the diagnosis and treatment of mental illness.
<b><u>psychopath</u></b>	Someone with a sociopathic personality a person with an antisocial personality disorder psychopath was once widely used but has now been superseded by sociopath. <i>Playground <b>psychopaths</b> will gather around a fight to encourage the combatants.</i>
<b>psychopathic</b>	Suffering from or constituting a chronic mental disorder with abnormal or violent social behaviour. <i>A <b>psychopathic</b> disorder.</i>
<b>raving</b>	In a raving manner. <i>The <b>ravings</b> of a madwoman.</i>
<b>schizophrenia</b>	(in general use) a mentality or approach characterized by inconsistent or contradictory elements. <i>Gibraltar's <b>schizophrenia</b> continues to be fed by colonial pride.</i>
<b>unbalanced</b>	Not giving accurate, fair, or equal coverage to all aspects; partial. <i>This may give an <b>unbalanced</b> impression of the competition.</i>
<b>wacko</b>	A crazy person. <i>A trailer park peopled by exotic <b>wackos</b> and misfits.</i>
