insane Extremely foolish; irrational.

insanity Relatively permanent disorder of the mind. It might be pure insanity to take this loan.

it might be pure **mountly** to take th

loon A silly or foolish person.

Foolish or senseless behavior.

lunatic Extremely foolish or eccentric.
