Definitions of "Analog" as a noun

- *Something having the property of being analogous to something else.*

A compound with a molecular structure closely similar to that of another.

analogue *The idea that the fertilized egg contains a miniature **analogue** of every adult structure.*

parallel *Each of the imaginary parallel circles of constant latitude on the earth's surface. **Parallels** never meet.*

Definitions of "Analog" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), "analog" as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Of a circuit or device having an output that is proportional to the input.*



Synonyms of "Analog" as an adjective (2 Words)

analogue (of a clock or watch) showing the time by means of hands or a pointer rather than displayed digits.

*The information on a gramophone record is **analogue**.*

linear Consisting of or predominantly formed using lines or outlines.
***Linear** elasticity.*
