## Associations of "Analogously" (30 Words)

<b>alike</b>	Having the same or similar characteristics. <i>The brothers were very much <b>alike</b>.</i>
<b>analogy</b>	The religious belief that between creature and creator no similarity can be found so great but that the dissimilarity is always greater any analogy between God and humans will always be inadequate. <i>Argument from <b>analogy</b>.</i>
<b>antithetic</b>	Sharply contrasted in character or purpose. <i>Hope is <b>antithetic</b> to despair.</i>
<b>as</b>	A United States territory on the eastern part of the island of Samoa. <i>Sang <b>as</b> sweetly <b>as</b> a nightingale.</i>
<b>assonance</b>	Resemblance of sound between syllables of nearby words, arising particularly from the rhyming of two or more stressed vowels, but not consonants (e.g. sonnet, porridge), but also from the use of identical consonants with different vowels (e.g. killed, cold, culled). <i>The use of <b>assonance</b> throughout the poem creates the sound of despair.</i>
<b><u>comparable</u></b>	Able to be likened to another; similar. <i>The situation in Holland is <b>comparable</b> to that in England.</i>
<b>compare</b>	Be of an equal or similar nature or quality. <i>John <b>compared</b> his haircut to his friend s.</i>
<b>comparison</b>	A consideration or estimate of the similarities or dissimilarities between two things or people. <i>Perhaps the best <b>comparison</b> is that of seasickness.</i>
<b><u>counterpart</u></b>	A person or thing that corresponds to or has the same function as another person or thing in a different place or situation. <i>The minister held talks with his French <b>counterpart</b>.</i>
<b><u>counterpoint</u></b>	Add counterpoint to a melody. <i>The cream walls and maple floors are <b>counterpointed</b> by black accents.</i>

<b>equal</b>	A person who is of equal standing with another in a group. <i>His work is concerned with why private property <b>equals</b> exploitation.</i>
<b><u>equate</u></b>	Cause (two or more things) to be the same in quantity or value. <i>Customers <b>equate</b> their name with quality.</i>
<b>equivalent</b>	Being essentially equal to something. <i>Some regulations are <b>equivalent</b> to censorship.</i>
<b>figurative</b>	Consisting of or forming human or animal figures- Herbert Read. <i>The <b>figurative</b> art of the humanistic tradition.</i>
<b><u>identical</u></b>	Having properties with uniform values along all axes. <i>Cars <b>identical</b> except for their license plates.</i>
<b>impartially</b>	In a way that treats all rivals or disputants equally. <i>The adjudicator should act <b>impartially</b> in carrying out his duties.</i>
<b>like</b>	A similar kind. <i>I was <b>like</b> so hyped up I couldn't go to sleep.</i>
<b>liken</b>	Consider or describe as similar, equal, or analogous. <i>Racism is <b>likened</b> to a contagious disease.</i>
<b>likeness</b>	A portrait or representation. <i>A family <b>likeness</b> can be seen in all the boys.</i>
<b>parallelism</b>	The use of parallel processing. <i>Greek thinkers who believed in the <b>parallelism</b> of microcosm and macrocosm.</i>
<b>proportionate</b>	Being in due proportion. <i><b>Proportionate</b> representation of a minority group.</i>
<b><u>resemblance</u></b>	A way in which two or more things are alike. <i>They bear some <b>resemblance</b> to Italian figurines.</i>
<b>same</b>	Similarly in the same way. <i>Two girls of the <b>same</b> age.</i>
<b>similar</b>	Resembling or similar having the same or some of the same characteristics often used in combination. <i>The principle of treatment by <b>similars</b>.</i>
<b>similarity</b>	The quality of being similar. <i>The <b>similarity</b> of symptoms makes them hard to diagnose.</i>
<b>similarly</b>	In like or similar manner. <i>He was <b>similarly</b> affected.</i>
<b>similitude</b>	Similarity in appearance or character or nature between persons or things. <i>There is a striking <b>similitude</b> between the brother and sister.</i>

**symmetrical** Made up of exactly similar parts facing each other or around an axis; showing symmetry.

*The shape of a hill smooth and **symmetrical**.*

**tantamount** Equivalent in seriousness to; virtually the same as.

*The resignations were **tantamount** to an admission of guilt.*

**twin** A twin engined aircraft.

*We have **twin** and three bedded rooms.*
