Present Tense	<b>anatomise / anatomises</b>
Past Tense	<b>anatomised</b>
Present Participle	<b>anatomising</b>
Past Participle	<b>anatomised</b>

## Conjugate Anatomise

### Anatomise in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **anatomise**                      We **anatomise**  
You **anatomise**                You **anatomise**  
He/She/It **anatomises**      They **anatomise**

**Anatomise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am anatomising**              We **are anatomising**  
You **are anatomising**        You **are anatomising**  
He/She/It **is anatomising**    They **are anatomising**

**Anatomise in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have anatomised**              We **have anatomised**  
You **have anatomised**        You **have anatomised**  
He/She/It **has anatomised**    They **have anatomised**

**Anatomise in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been anatomising**        We **have been anatomising**  
You **have been anatomising**    You **have been anatomising**  
He/She/It **has been anatomising**    They **have been anatomising**

**Anatomise in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **anatomised**                      We **anatomised**  
You **anatomised**                You **anatomised**  
He/She/It **anatomised**        They **anatomised**

**Anatomise in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was anatomising      We were anatomising  
You were anatomising      You were anatomising  
He/She/It was anatomising      They were anatomising

**Anatomise in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had anatomised      We had anatomised  
You had anatomised      You had anatomised  
He/She/It had anatomised      They had anatomised

**Anatomise in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been anatomising      We had been anatomising  
You had been anatomising      You had been anatomising  
He/She/It had been anatomising      They had been anatomising

**Anatomise in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will anatomise      We will anatomise  
You will anatomise      You will anatomise  
He/She/It will anatomise      They will anatomise

**Anatomise in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be anatomising      We will be anatomising  
You will be anatomising      You will be anatomising  
He/She/It will be anatomising      They will be anatomising

**Anatomise in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have anatomised**

**We will have anatomised**

**You will have anatomised**

**You will have anatomised**

**He/She/It will have anatomised**

**They will have anatomised**

**Anatomise in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**I will have been anatomising**

**We will have been anatomising**

**You will have been anatomising**

**You will have been anatomising**

**He/She/It will have been anatomising**

**They will have been anatomising**
