hereby	By means of this. I hereby declare you man and wife.
hitherto	Until now or until the point in time under discussion. Hitherto part of French West Africa Benin achieved independence in 1960.
later	Happening at a time subsequent to a reference time. Later on it will be easier.
overly	To a degree exceeding normal or proper limits. She was a jealous and overly possessive woman.
pluperfect	The pluperfect tense. He spoke with pluperfect precision.
really	Used as intensifiers real is sometimes used informally for really rattling is informal. I m sorry Ruth I really am.
sometime	Belonging to some prior time. The Emperor Constantine used this speech sometime unto his bishops.

therefore	From that fact or reason or as a result used to introduce a logical conclusion therefore adv as a consequence. Therefore X must be true.
thereof	From that circumstance or source- W.V.Quine. The member state or a part thereof .
