<b>enable</b>	Render capable or able for some task. <i>The rope <b>enables</b> you to secure yourself when you climb the mountain.</i>
<b>enabling</b>	Providing legal power or sanction. <i><b>Enabling</b> power.</i>
<b>facilitate</b>	Increase the likelihood of (a response). <i>Schools were located in the same campus to <b>facilitate</b> the sharing of resources.</i>
<b>far</b>	To an advanced stage or point. <i>The mountains <b>far</b> in the distance glowed in the sun.</i>

<b>farther</b>	To or at a greater distance in time or space farther is used more frequently than further in this physical sense. <i><b>Farther</b> from our expectations.</i>
<b>hence</b>	From that fact or reason or as a result used to introduce a logical conclusion hence adv from this place. <i>Many vehicle journeys and <b>hence</b> a lot of pollution would be saved.</i>
<b>hereby</b>	By means of this. <i>I <b>hereby</b> declare you man and wife.</i>
<b>hitherto</b>	Until now or until the point in time under discussion. <i><b>Hitherto</b> part of French West Africa Benin achieved independence in 1960.</i>
<b>later</b>	Happening at a time subsequent to a reference time. <i><b>Later</b> on it will be easier.</i>
<b>overly</b>	To a degree exceeding normal or proper limits. <i>She was a jealous and <b>overly</b> possessive woman.</i>
<b>pluperfect</b>	The pluperfect tense. <i>He spoke with <b>pluperfect</b> precision.</i>
<b>really</b>	Used as intensifiers real is sometimes used informally for really rattling is informal. <i>I m sorry Ruth I <b>really</b> am.</i>
<b>sometime</b>	Belonging to some prior time. <i>The Emperor Constantine used this speech <b>sometime</b> unto his bishops.</i>
<b>subsequently</b>	Happening at a time subsequent to a reference time. <i>The officer decided to stop and <b>subsequently</b> made an arrest.</i>
<b>terribly</b>	Very badly or unpleasantly. <i>I m <b>terribly</b> sorry.</i>
<b>then</b>	Used at the end of a sentence to emphasize an inference being drawn. <i>The <b>then</b> president.</i>
<b>thereby</b>	By that means; as a result of that. <i>Students perform in hospitals <b>thereby</b> gaining a deeper awareness of the therapeutic power of music.</i>
<b>therefore</b>	From that fact or reason or as a result used to introduce a logical conclusion therefore adv as a consequence. <i><b>Therefore</b> X must be true.</i>
<b>thereof</b>	From that circumstance or source- W.V.Quine. <i>The member state or a part <b>thereof</b>.</i>

**truly**

In fact (used as intensifiers or sentence modifiers).  
*This is **truly** a miracle.*

**very**

With no addition of anything else; mere.  
*The **very** first time.*
