<b>angelical</b>	Marked by utter benignity; resembling or befitting an angel or saint.
<b>beatific</b>	Marked by utter benignity; resembling or befitting an angel or saint. <i>Beatific peace.</i>
<b>celestial</b>	Relating to or inhabiting a divine heaven. <i>A celestial body.</i>
<b>cherubic</b>	Having a sweet nature befitting an angel or cherub. <i>A round cherubic face.</i>
<b>divine</b>	Resulting from divine providence. <i>The divine Shakespeare.</i>
<b>exemplary</b>	(of damages) exceeding the amount needed for simple compensation. <i>Exemplary sentencing may discourage the violent minority.</i>
<b>good</b>	Giving pleasure; enjoyable or satisfying. <i>A good time to plant tomatoes.</i>

<b>heavenly</b>	Of or relating to the sky. <i>Heavenly constellations.</i>
<b>holy</b>	Dedicated or consecrated to God or a religious purpose; sacred. <i>Saints and holy men.</i>
<b>innocent</b>	Not knowledgeable about something specified. <i>She is a poor innocent young creature.</i>
<b>pure</b>	Being chromatically pure not diluted with white or grey or black. <i>Our fondness for each other is pure and innocent.</i>
<b>sainted</b>	Formally recognized as a saint; canonized. <i>He s a sainted figure on the Left holding one of the highest seats in their pantheon.</i>
<b>saintlike</b>	Marked by utter benignity; resembling or befitting an angel or saint.
<b>saintly</b>	Marked by utter benignity; resembling or befitting an angel or saint. <i>A truly saintly woman.</i>
<b>seraphic</b>	Of or relating to an angel of the first order. <i>Looking so seraphic when he slept.</i>
<b>sweet</b>	Having a sweet nature befitting an angel or cherub. <i>The sweet notes of the flute.</i>
<b>virtuous</b>	Morally excellent. <i>She considered herself very virtuous because she neither drank nor smoked.</i>
<b>wholesome</b>	Conducive to or suggestive of good health and physical well-being. <i>Good wholesome fun.</i>

<b>cherubic</b>	Having the innocence or plump prettiness of a young child. <i>A round <b>cherubic</b> face.</i>
<b>dedicated</b>	Solemnly dedicated to or set apart for a high or sacred purpose. <i>A team of <b>dedicated</b> doctors.</i>
<u><a href="#">devout</a></u>	Deeply religious H.L.Mencken. <i>The most <b>devout</b> environmentalist.</i>
<u><a href="#">divine</a></u>	Resulting from divine providence. <i>Paintings of shipwrecks being prevented by <b>divine</b> intervention.</i>
<b>ecclesiastic</b>	Of or associated with a church (especially a Christian Church). <i><b>Ecclesiastic</b> history.</i>
<b>godly</b>	Devoutly religious; pious. <i>Everything is black or white satanic or <b>godly</b>.</i>
<b>hallowed</b>	Made holy; consecrated. <i><b>Hallowed</b> ground.</i>
<u><a href="#">heavenly</a></u>	Of or belonging to heaven or god. <i>Their shampoos smell <b>heavenly</b>.</i>
<b>holy</b>	Dedicated or consecrated to God or a religious purpose; sacred. <i>I do not lead a <b>holy</b> life.</i>
<b>liturgy</b>	A religious service conducted according to a liturgy. <i>At the conclusion of the <b>liturgy</b> the Bishop presented the certificates.</i>
<b>omniscience</b>	The state of being omniscient; having infinite knowledge. <i>His reputation for near <b>omniscience</b> and infallibility.</i>
<b>pharisaic</b>	Excessively or hypocritically pious.
<u><a href="#">pilgrimage</a></u>	Go on a pilgrimage. <i>A place of <b>pilgrimage</b>.</i>
<u><a href="#">pious</a></u>	(of a hope) sincere but unlikely to be fulfilled. <i>His <b>pious</b> platitudes.</i>
<b>religious</b>	A member of a religious order who is bound by vows of poverty and chastity and obedience. <i>A <b>religious</b> man.</i>
<u><a href="#">reverent</a></u>	Showing great reverence for god. <i>A <b>reverent</b> silence.</i>
<u><a href="#">reverential</a></u>	Of the nature of, due to, or characterized by reverence. <i>Their names are always mentioned in <b>reverential</b> tones.</i>

<b>sacrament</b>	(in Roman Catholic use) the consecrated elements of the Eucharist, especially the bread or Host. <i>They used peyote as a <b>sacrament</b>.</i>
<b>sacred</b>	Made or declared or believed to be holy; devoted to a deity or some religious ceremony or use. <i>Cows are <b>sacred</b> and the eating of beef is taboo.</i>
<b>sacrilege</b>	Blasphemous behavior; the act of depriving something of its sacred character. <i>Putting ecclesiastical vestments to secular use was considered <b>sacrilege</b>.</i>
<b>saintly</b>	Marked by utter benignity; resembling or befitting an angel or saint. <i>A crypt for some <b>saintly</b> relic.</i>
<a href="#"><u>sanctity</u></a>	The quality of being holy. <i>The site of the tomb was a place of <b>sanctity</b> for the ancient Egyptians.</i>
<b>scripture</b>	Any writing that is regarded as sacred by a religious group. <i>The fundamental teachings of the <b>scriptures</b>.</i>
<b>seraphic</b>	Of or relating to an angel of the first order. <i>He imagined a <b>seraphic</b> presence in the room.</i>
<a href="#"><u>shrine</u></a>	Enshrine. <i>A Hindu <b>shrine</b> at which offerings are placed twice a day.</i>
<b>supernal</b>	Of exceptional quality or extent. <i><b>Supernal</b> erudition.</i>
