antagonism

The relation between opposing principles or forces or factors.

The inherent **antagonism** of capitalism and socialism.

A state or feeling of being dissatisfied, especially with people in authority or

indignation A feeling of righteous anger.

The letter filled Lucy with **indignation**.

inflame Become inflamed get sore.

The repetitive motion **inflame**d her joint.

infuriate Make (someone) extremely angry and impatient.

I was **infuriate**d by your article.

irritate Excite to an abnormal condition, or chafe or inflame.

Irritate the glands of a leaf.

A sudden outburst of anger.

Any food produced **irritation** of the stomach.

madden Drive (someone or something) insane.

This is ridiculous she told him **madden**ed by his reaction.

A state of irritation or annoyance.

miff A doctor might be **miff**ed by claims that the cure had no medical

explanation.

offend Be displeasing or cause problems to.

Those activities which **offend** against public order and decency.

outrage An action or event causing outrage.

The public were **outrage**d at the brutality involved.

Having or showing an irritable disposition.

peevishA thin **peevish** voice.

A unin **peevisii** voice.

petulantEasily irritated or annoyed.

A petulant shake of the head.



pique A sudden outburst of anger.

She was **pique**d by his curtness.

rage Violent state of the elements.

She fell into a **rage** and refused to answer.

resentment A feeling of deep and bitter anger and ill-will.

His **resentment** at being demoted.

sadden Cause to feel sorrow; make unhappy.

The news of her death **sadden**ed me.

testy Easily irritated or annoyed.

She could see him growing quite **testy** beneath that polished urbanity.

touchy Quick to take offense.

She s a little **touchy** about her age.

Make or become worse.

worsen

Arguing actually worsens the problem.
