Infinitive	<b>to angle</b>
Present Tense	<b>angle / angles</b>
Past Tense	<b>angled</b>
Present Participle	<b>angling</b>
Past Participle	<b>angled</b>

## Conjugate Angle

**Angle in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>angle</b>	We <b>angle</b>
You <b>angle</b>	You <b>angle</b>
He/She/It <b>angles</b>	They <b>angle</b>

### **Angle in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am angling</b>	We <b>are angling</b>
You <b>are angling</b>	You <b>are angling</b>
He/She/It <b>is angling</b>	They <b>are angling</b>

### **Angle in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have angled</b>	We <b>have angled</b>
You <b>have angled</b>	You <b>have angled</b>
He/She/It <b>has angled</b>	They <b>have angled</b>

### **Angle in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have been angling</b>	We <b>have been angling</b>
You <b>have been angling</b>	You <b>have been angling</b>
He/She/It <b>has been angling</b>	They <b>have been angling</b>

### **Angle in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>angled</b>	We <b>angled</b>
You <b>angled</b>	You <b>angled</b>
He/She/It <b>angled</b>	They <b>angled</b>

### **Angle in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was angling	We were angling
You were angling	You were angling
He/She/It was angling	They were angling

**Angle in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had angled	We had angled
You had angled	You had angled
He/She/It had angled	They had angled

**Angle in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been angling	We had been angling
You had been angling	You had been angling
He/She/It had been angling	They had been angling

**Angle in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will angle	We will angle
You will angle	You will angle
He/She/It will angle	They will angle

**Angle in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be angling	We will be angling
You will be angling	You will be angling
He/She/It will be angling	They will be angling

**Angle in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have angled**

**We will have angled**

**You will have angled**

**You will have angled**

**He/She/It will have angled**

**They will have angled**

**Angle in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been angling**

**We will have been angling**

**You will have been angling**

**You will have been angling**

**He/She/It will have been angling**

**They will have been angling**
