Infinitive	<b>to angst</b>
Present Tense	<b>angst / angsts</b>
Past Tense	<b>angsted</b>
Present Participle	<b>angsting</b>
Past Participle	<b>angsted</b>

## Conjugate Angst

**Angst in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>angst</b>	We <b>angst</b>
You <b>angst</b>	You <b>angst</b>
He/She/It <b>angsts</b>	They <b>angst</b>

### **Angst in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am angsting</b>	We <b>are angsting</b>
You <b>are angsting</b>	You <b>are angsting</b>
He/She/It <b>is angsting</b>	They <b>are angsting</b>

### **Angst in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have angsted</b>	We <b>have angsted</b>
You <b>have angsted</b>	You <b>have angsted</b>
He/She/It <b>has angsted</b>	They <b>have angsted</b>

I <b>have been angsting</b>	We <b>have been angsting</b>
You <b>have been angsting</b>	You <b>have been angsting</b>
He/She/It <b>has been angsting</b>	They <b>have been angsting</b>

You <b>were angsting</b>	You <b>were angsting</b>
He/She/It <b>was angsting</b>	They <b>were angsting</b>

I <b>had angsted</b>	We <b>had angsted</b>
You <b>had angsted</b>	You <b>had angsted</b>
He/She/It <b>had angsted</b>	They <b>had angsted</b>

I <b>had been angsting</b>	We <b>had been angsting</b>
You <b>had been angsting</b>	You <b>had been angsting</b>
He/She/It <b>had been angsting</b>	They <b>had been angsting</b>

**Angst in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

I <b>will angst</b>	We <b>will angst</b>
You <b>will angst</b>	You <b>will angst</b>
He/She/It <b>will angst</b>	They <b>will angst</b>

**Angst in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

I <b>will be angsting</b>	We <b>will be angsting</b>
You <b>will be angsting</b>	You <b>will be angsting</b>
He/She/It <b>will be angsting</b>	They <b>will be angsting</b>

**Angst in Future Perfect Tense**

**I will have angsted**

**We will have angsted**

**You will have angsted**

**You will have angsted**

**He/She/It will have angsted**

**They will have angsted**

**Angst in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**I will have been angsting**

**We will have been angsting**

**You will have been angsting**

**You will have been angsting**

**He/She/It will have been angsting**

**They will have been angsting**
