Infinitive	<b>to anhydrate</b>
Present Tense	<b>anhydrate / anhydrates</b>
Past Tense	<b>anhydrated</b>
Present Participle	<b>anhydrating</b>
Past Participle	<b>anhydrated</b>

## Conjugate Anhydrate

**Anhydrate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>anhydrate</b>	We <b>anhydrate</b>
You <b>anhydrate</b>	You <b>anhydrate</b>
He/She/It <b>anhydrates</b>	They <b>anhydrate</b>

**Anhydrate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>am anhydrating</b>	We <b>are anhydrating</b>
You <b>are anhydrating</b>	You <b>are anhydrating</b>
He/She/It <b>is anhydrating</b>	They <b>are anhydrating</b>

**Anhydrate in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have anhydrated</b>	We <b>have anhydrated</b>
You <b>have anhydrated</b>	You <b>have anhydrated</b>
He/She/It <b>has anhydrated</b>	They <b>have anhydrated</b>

**Anhydrate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

I <b>have been anhydrating</b>	We <b>have been anhydrating</b>
You <b>have been anhydrating</b>	You <b>have been anhydrating</b>
He/She/It <b>has been anhydrating</b>	They <b>have been anhydrating</b>

<b>I was anhydrating</b>	<b>We were anhydrating</b>
<b>You were anhydrating</b>	<b>You were anhydrating</b>
<b>He/She/It was anhydrating</b>	<b>They were anhydrating</b>

**Anhydrate in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I had anhydrated</b>	<b>We had anhydrated</b>
<b>You had anhydrated</b>	<b>You had anhydrated</b>
<b>He/She/It had anhydrated</b>	<b>They had anhydrated</b>

**Anhydrate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I had been anhydrating</b>	<b>We had been anhydrating</b>
<b>You had been anhydrating</b>	<b>You had been anhydrating</b>
<b>He/She/It had been anhydrating</b>	<b>They had been anhydrating</b>

<b>I will anhydrate</b>	<b>We will anhydrate</b>
<b>You will anhydrate</b>	<b>You will anhydrate</b>
<b>He/She/It will anhydrate</b>	<b>They will anhydrate</b>

<b>I will be anhydrating</b>	<b>We will be anhydrating</b>
