Infinitive	<b>to annoy</b>
Present Tense	<b>annoy / annoys</b>
Past Tense	<b>annoyed</b>
Present Participle	<b>annoying</b>
Past Participle	<b>annoyed</b>

## Conjugate Annoy

**Annoy in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **annoy**                  We **annoy**  
You **annoy**              You **annoy**  
He/She/It **annoys**    They **annoy**

**Annoy in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **am annoying**              We **are annoying**  
You **are annoying**          You **are annoying**  
He/She/It **is annoying**    They **are annoying**

**Annoy in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **have annoyed**              We **have annoyed**  
You **have annoyed**          You **have annoyed**  
He/She/It **has annoyed**    They **have annoyed**

**Annoy in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **have been annoying**          We **have been annoying**  
You **have been annoying**      You **have been annoying**  
He/She/It **has been annoying**    They **have been annoying**

**Annoy in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **annoyed**                  We **annoyed**  
You **annoyed**              You **annoyed**  
He/She/It **annoyed**      They **annoyed**

**Annoy in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was annoying	We were annoying
You were annoying	You were annoying
He/She/It was annoying	They were annoying

**Annoy in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had annoyed	We had annoyed
You had annoyed	You had annoyed
He/She/It had annoyed	They had annoyed

**Annoy in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been annoying	We had been annoying
You had been annoying	You had been annoying
He/She/It had been annoying	They had been annoying

**Annoy in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will annoy	We will annoy
You will annoy	You will annoy
He/She/It will annoy	They will annoy

**Annoy in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be annoying	We will be annoying
You will be annoying	You will be annoying
He/She/It will be annoying	They will be annoying

**Annoy in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have annoyed**

**We will have annoyed**

**You will have annoyed**

**You will have annoyed**

**He/She/It will have annoyed**

**They will have annoyed**

**Annoy in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been annoying**

**We will have been annoying**

**You will have been annoying**

**You will have been annoying**

**He/She/It will have been annoying**

**They will have been annoying**
