## Annual as a Noun

### Definitions of "Annual" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “annual” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A book or magazine that is published once a year under the same title but with different contents.*
- *(botany) a plant that completes its entire life cycle within the space of a year.*
- *A plant that completes its entire life cycle within the space of a year.*
- *A reference book that is published regularly once every year.*
- *An annual plant.*



### Synonyms of "Annual" as a noun (2 Words)

**yearbook** A book published annually by the graduating class of a high school or college usually containing photographs of faculty and graduating students.

*The Rugby Union **Yearbook**.*

## Annual as an Adjective

### Definitions of "Annual" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “annual” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Occurring once every year.*
- *Completing its life cycle within a year.*
- *Calculated over or covering a period of a year.*
- *(of a plant) living only for a year or less, perpetuating itself by seed.*
- *Occurring or payable every year.*





## Synonyms of "Annual" as an adjective (4 Words)

**every twelve months** Each and all of a series of entities or intervals as specified.

**lasting a year** Existing for a long time.

**one-year** Completing its life cycle within a year.

[yearly](#) Done, produced, or occurring once a year or every year.

***Yearly*** *medical examinations.*

## Associations of "Annual" (30 Words)

<b>almanac</b>	An annual publication containing tabular information in a particular field or fields arranged according to the calendar of a given year.
<b>annually</b>	Without missing a year. <i>They travel to China <b>annually</b>.</i>
<b><u>audit</u></b>	A methodical examination or review of a condition or situation. <i><b>Audits</b> can't be expected to detect every fraud.</i>
<b><u>biannual</u></b>	Occurring or payable twice each year. <i>The <b>biannual</b> meeting of the planning committee.</i>
<b>biennial</b>	A plant having a life cycle that normally takes two seasons from germination to death to complete flowering; biennials usually bloom and fruit in the second season. <i>Parsnips and carrots are <b>biennial</b> plants often grown as annuals.</i>
<b>bimonthly</b>	Twice a month. <i><b>Bimonthly</b> visits.</i>

<b>biweekly</b>	Occurring every two weeks. <i>She followed her doctor's instructions to undergo health checks <b>biweekly</b>.</i>
<b>celebration</b>	The action of celebrating an important day or event. <i>A birthday <b>celebration</b>.</i>
<b>cyclical</b>	Occurring in cycles; recurrent. <i>The <b>cyclical</b> nature of the cement industry.</i>
<b>daily</b>	Of or belonging to or occurring every day. <i>Boats can be hired for a <b>daily</b> rate.</i>
<b>day-to-day</b>	United States writer best known for his autobiographical works (1874-1935).
<b>deductible</b>	Acceptable as a deduction (especially as a tax deduction). <i>Childcare vouchers will be <b>deductible</b> expenses for employers.</i>
<b>diurnal</b>	Of or during the day. <i><b>Diurnal</b> aberration.</i>
<b>inauguration</b>	The formal admission of someone to office. <i>He opposed the <b>inauguration</b> of fluoridation.</i>
<b>monthly</b>	A periodical that is published every month (or 12 issues per year). <i>An Anglo American <b>monthly</b> whose appeal was always international.</i>
<b>oft</b>	Many times at short intervals. <i>An <b>oft</b> quoted tenet.</i>
<b>perennial</b>	A perennial plant. <i><b>Perennial</b> manifestations of urban crisis.</i>
<b>perennially</b>	In a perennial manner; repeatedly. <i>A lily that grows <b>perennially</b> from bulbs.</i>
<b>periodic</b>	Relating to the periodic table of the elements. <i>The <b>periodic</b> appearance of the seventeen year locust.</i>
<b>periodical</b>	A publication that appears at fixed intervals. <i>She took <b>periodical</b> gulps of her tea.</i>
<b>periodicity</b>	The quality or character of being periodic; the tendency to recur at intervals. <i>The <b>periodicity</b> of the sunspot cycle.</i>
<b>quarterly</b>	A periodical that is published every quarter (or four issues per year). <i>Interest is paid <b>quarterly</b>.</i>
<b>regular</b>	A regular customer member of a team etc. <i>Her breathing became more <b>regular</b>.</i>
<b>regularly</b>	In a way that follows the normal pattern of inflection. <i><b>Regularly</b> spaced buildings.</i>
<b>semiannual</b>	Occurring or payable twice each year.



**tercentenary** The three-hundredth anniversary of a significant event.  
*Events arranged to mark the Library's **tercentenary**.*

**triennial** Lasting for or relating to a period of three years.  
*The **triennial** meeting of the Association.*

**weekly** A periodical that is published every week (or 52 issues per year).  
*A **weekly** visit.*

**year** A period similar to a year used for reckoning time according to other calendars.  
*It's almost a **year** since his heart attack.*

**yearly** Done, produced, or occurring once a year or every year.  
*Annual or **yearly** income.*
