Conjugate Annunciate

Annunciate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I annunciate	We annunciate
You annunciate	You annunciate
He/She/It annunciates	They annunciate

Annunciate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am annunciating	We are annunciating
You are annunciating	You are annunciating
He/She/It is annunciating	They are annunciating

Annunciate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have annunciated	We have annunciated
You have annunciated	You have annunciated
He/She/It has annunciated	They have annunciated

Annunciate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been annunciating	We have been annunciating
You have been annunciating	You have been annunciating
He/She/It has been annunciating	They have been annunciating

Annunciate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I annunciated	We annunciated
You annunciated	You annunciated
He/She/It annunciated	They annunciated

Annunciate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was annunciating	We were annunciating
You were annunciating	You were annunciating
He/She/It was annunciating	They were annunciating

Annunciate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had annunciated	We had annunciated
You had annunciated	You had annunciated
He/She/It had annunciated	They had annunciated

Annunciate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been annunciating	We had been annunciating
You had been annunciating	You had been annunciating
He/She/It had been annunciating	They had been annunciating

Annunciate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will annunciate	We will annunciate
You will annunciate	You will annunciate
He/She/It will annunciate	They will annunciate

Annunciate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be annunciating	We will be annunciating
You will be annunciating	You will be annunciating
He/She/It will be annunciating	They will be annunciating
