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## Associations of "Another word for sexy" (30 Words)

<b>alphabet</b>	The elementary stages of any subject (usually plural). <i>The first letter of the <b>alphabet</b>.</i>
<b>antonym</b>	A word that expresses a meaning opposed to the meaning of another word in which case the two words are antonyms of each other. <i>To him the <b>antonym</b> of gay was depressed.</i>
<b><a href="#">bilingual</a></b>	(of a country, city, or other community) using two languages, especially officially. <i><b>Bilingual</b> education.</i>
<b>collocation</b>	A grouping of words in a sentence. <i>The words have a similar range of <b>collocation</b>.</i>
<b>derivation</b>	The process whereby new words are formed from existing words or bases by affixation. <i>Music of primarily Turkish <b>derivation</b>.</i>
<b><a href="#">derivative</a></b>	An arrangement or product (such as a future, option, or warrant) whose value derives from and is dependent on the value of an underlying asset, such as a commodity, currency, or security. <i>Equity based <b>derivative</b> products.</i>
<b>dictionary</b>	A set of words or other text strings made for use in applications such as spellcheckers. <i>The worm attempts to crack account passwords using a built in <b>dictionary</b>.</i>
<b>diphthong</b>	A digraph representing the sound of a diphthong or single vowel as in feat.
<b>grammar</b>	A book on grammar. <i>My old Latin <b>grammar</b>.</i>
<b>grammarian</b>	A linguist who specializes in the study of grammar and syntax.
<b>homonym</b>	Two words are homonyms if they are pronounced and spelled the same way but have different meanings.

<b>interpreter</b>	Someone who mediates between speakers of different languages. <i>She was famous as an <b>interpreter</b> of Shakespearean roles.</i>
<b>language</b>	Language communication by word of mouth. <i>A study of the way children learn <b>language</b>.</i>
<b>lexicographer</b>	A compiler or writer of a dictionary; a student of the lexical component of language.
<b>lexicon</b>	A reference book containing an alphabetical list of words with information about them. <i>The size of the English <b>lexicon</b>.</i>
<b>meaning</b>	Rich in significance or implication. <i>What is the <b>meaning</b> of this proverb.</i>
<b>multilingual</b>	Using or knowing more than one language. <i>A <b>multilingual</b> nation.</i>
<b>noun</b>	A word other than a pronoun used to identify any of a class of people places or things common noun or to name a particular one of these proper noun.
<b>orthography</b>	The conventional spelling system of a language. <i>A spoken language which has as yet no sanctioned <b>orthography</b>.</i>
<b>paragraph</b>	Arrange a piece of writing in paragraphs. <i>The concluding <b>paragraph</b>.</i>
<b>philologist</b>	A humanist specializing in classical scholarship.
<b>phonetic</b>	Relating to phonetics. <i><b>Phonetic</b> training.</i>
<b>pronunciation</b>	The way in which a word is pronounced. <i>That is the correct <b>pronunciation</b>.</i>
<b>sentence</b>	Pronounce a sentence on somebody in a court of law. <i>Ten army officers were <b>sentenced</b> to life imprisonment.</i>
<b>spelling</b>	The process or activity of writing or naming the letters of a word. <i>The books and <b>spelling</b> in my class were too simple.</i>
<b>term</b>	Name formally or designate with a term. <i>A <b>term</b> of abuse.</i>
<b>translator</b>	A program that translates one programming language into another. <i>The <b>translator</b> of Hardy s poems into Icelandic.</i>
<b>verb</b>	Use a word that is not conventionally used as a verb typically a noun as a verb. <i>Any English noun can be <b>verbed</b> but some are more resistant than others.</i>

**vocabulary** A range of artistic or stylistic forms, techniques, or movements.  
*He had a wide **vocabulary**.*

**vowel** A letter representing a vowel sound such as a e i o u.
