Infinitive	<b>to antagonise</b>
Present Tense	<b>antagonise / antagonises</b>
Past Tense	<b>antagonised</b>
Present Participle	<b>antagonising</b>
Past Participle	<b>antagonised</b>

**Antagonise in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **antagonise**                      We **antagonise**  
You **antagonise**                    You **antagonise**  
He/She/It **antagonises**      They **antagonise**

**Antagonise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am antagonising**                We **are antagonising**  
You **are antagonising**            You **are antagonising**  
He/She/It **is antagonising**      They **are antagonising**

**Antagonise in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have antagonised**                We **have antagonised**  
You **have antagonised**            You **have antagonised**  
He/She/It **has antagonised**      They **have antagonised**

**Antagonise in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

I **have been antagonising**        We **have been antagonising**  
You **have been antagonising**    You **have been antagonising**  
He/She/It **has been antagonising**      They **have been antagonising**

**Antagonise in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Plural**

I **antagonised**                      We **antagonised**  
You **antagonised**                    You **antagonised**  
He/She/It **antagonised**          They **antagonised**

**Antagonise in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was antagonising      We were antagonising  
You were antagonising      You were antagonising  
He/She/It was antagonising      They were antagonising

**Antagonise in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had antagonised      We had antagonised  
You had antagonised      You had antagonised  
He/She/It had antagonised      They had antagonised

**Antagonise in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

I had been antagonising      We had been antagonising  
You had been antagonising      You had been antagonising  
He/She/It had been antagonising      They had been antagonising

**Antagonise in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will antagonise      We will antagonise  
You will antagonise      You will antagonise  
He/She/It will antagonise      They will antagonise

**Antagonise in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be antagonising      We will be antagonising  
You will be antagonising      You will be antagonising  
He/She/It will be antagonising      They will be antagonising

**I will have antagonised**

**We will have antagonised**

**You will have antagonised**

**You will have antagonised**

**He/She/It will have antagonised**

**They will have antagonised**

**I will have been antagonising**

**We will have been antagonising**

**You will have been antagonising**

**You will have been antagonising**

**He/She/It will have been antagonising**

**They will have been antagonising**
