Definitions of "Anti" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “anti” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Not in favor of (an action or proposal etc.*
- *Opposed.*



Synonyms of "Anti" as an adjective (5 Words)

- antagonistic** Showing or feeling active opposition or hostility towards someone or something.
*An **antagonistic** group of bystanders.*
- averse** Strongly opposed.
*The bank's approach has been risk **averse**.*
- hostile** Opposed.
*A **hostile** audience.*
- opposed** In conflict with or hostile to.
*Parties **opposed** to the ruling party.*
- unsympathetic** Not having an open mind.
*All the characters were peculiarly **unsympathetic**.*



Usage Examples of "Anti" as an adjective

- *The local councils are anti.*
