- *Not in favor of (an action or proposal etc.*
- *Opposed.*



## Synonyms of "Anti" as an adjective (5 Words)

<b>antagonistic</b>	Showing or feeling active opposition or hostility towards someone or something. <i>An <b>antagonistic</b> group of bystanders.</i>
<b>averse</b>	Strongly opposed. <i>The bank's approach has been risk <b>averse</b>.</i>
<b><u>hostile</u></b>	Opposed. <i>A <b>hostile</b> audience.</i>
<b>opposed</b>	In conflict with or hostile to. <i>Parties <b>opposed</b> to the ruling party.</i>
<b>unsympathetic</b>	Not having an open mind. <i>All the characters were peculiarly <b>unsympathetic</b>.</i>
