# **Conjugate Antic**

## Antic in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>antic</b>	We <b>antic</b>
You <b>antic</b>	You <b>antic</b>
He/She/It antics	They <b>antic</b>

## Antic in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am anticking	We <b>are anticking</b>
You <b>are anticking</b>	You <b>are anticking</b>
He/She/It is anticking	They are anticking

### **Antic in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have anticked	We have anticked
You have anticked	You have anticked
He/She/It has anticked	They have anticked

### **Antic in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been anticking	We have been anticking
You have been anticking	You have been anticking
He/She/It has been anticking	They have been anticking

## Antic in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I <b>anticked</b>	We <b>anticked</b>
You <b>anticked</b>	You <b>anticked</b>
He/She/It anticked	They <b>anticked</b>

## Antic in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was anticking	We were anticking
You <b>were anticking</b>	You were anticking
He/She/It was anticking	They were anticking

#### **Antic in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had anticked	We had anticked
You <b>had anticked</b>	You had anticked
He/She/It had anticked	They had anticked

### **Antic in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been anticking	We had been anticking
You <b>had been anticking</b>	You had been anticking
He/She/It had been anticking	They had been anticking

### Antic in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will antic	We will antic
You <b>will antic</b>	You <b>will antic</b>
He/She/It will antic	They will antic

### Antic in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

SingularPluralI will be antickingWe will be antickingYou will be antickingYou will be antickingHe/She/It will be antickingThey will be anticking

#### **Antic in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have antickedWe will have antickedYou will have antickedYou will have antickedHe/She/It will have antickedThey will have anticked

#### **Antic in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been anticking	We <b>will have been anticking</b>
You <b>will have been anticking</b>	You <b>will have been anticking</b>
He/She/It will have been anticking	They will have been anticking
