Anticipate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular**Plural**

I **anticipate** We **anticipate**
You **anticipate** You **anticipate**
He/She/It **anticipates** They **anticipate**

Anticipate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**Singular****Plural**

I **am anticipating** We **are anticipating**
You **are anticipating** You **are anticipating**
He/She/It **is anticipating** They **are anticipating**

Anticipate in Present Perfect Tense**Singular****Plural**

I **have anticipated** We **have anticipated**
You **have anticipated** You **have anticipated**
He/She/It **has anticipated** They **have anticipated**

Anticipate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**Singular****Plural**

I **have been anticipating** We **have been anticipating**
You **have been anticipating** You **have been anticipating**
He/She/It **has been anticipating** They **have been anticipating**

Anticipate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**Singular****Plural**

I **anticipated** We **anticipated**
You **anticipated** You **anticipated**
He/She/It **anticipated** They **anticipated**

Anticipate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular**Plural**

I was anticipating	We were anticipating
You were anticipating	You were anticipating
He/She/It was anticipating	They were anticipating

Anticipate in Past Perfect Tense**Singular****Plural**

I had anticipated	We had anticipated
You had anticipated	You had anticipated
He/She/It had anticipated	They had anticipated

Anticipate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**Singular****Plural**

I had been anticipating	We had been anticipating
You had been anticipating	You had been anticipating
He/She/It had been anticipating	They had been anticipating

Anticipate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**Singular****Plural**

I will anticipate	We will anticipate
You will anticipate	You will anticipate
He/She/It will anticipate	They will anticipate

Anticipate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**Singular****Plural**

I will be anticipating	We will be anticipating
You will be anticipating	You will be anticipating
He/She/It will be anticipating	They will be anticipating
