Conjugate Apparel

Apparel in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I apparel	We apparel
You apparel	You apparel
He/She/It apparels	They apparel

Apparel in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am appareling or apparelling	We are appareling or apparelling
You are appareling or apparelling	You are appareling or apparelling
He/She/It is appareling or apparelling	They are appareling or apparelling

Apparel in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have appareled or apparelled	We have appareled or apparelled
You have appareled or apparelled	You have appareled or apparelled
He/She/It has appareled or apparelled	They have appareled or apparelled

Apparel in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been appareling or apparelling	We have been appareling or apparelling
You have been appareling or apparelling	You have been appareling or apparelling
He/She/It has been appareling or apparelling	They have been appareling or apparelling

Apparel in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I appareled or apparelled	We appareled or apparelled
You appareled or apparelled	You appareled or apparelled
He/She/It appareled or apparelled	They appareled or apparelled



Apparel in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I was appareling or apparelling	We were appareling or apparelling
You were appareling or apparelling	You were appareling or apparelling
He/She/It was appareling or apparelling	They were appareling or apparelling

Apparel in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had appareled or apparelled	We had appareled or apparelled
You had appareled or apparelled	You had appareled or apparelled
He/She/It had appareled or apparelled	I They had appareled or apparelled

Apparel in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been appareling or apparelling	We had been appareling or apparelling
You had been appareling or apparelling	You had been appareling or apparelling
He/She/It had been appareling or apparelling	They had been appareling or apparelling

Apparel in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will apparel	We will apparel
You will apparel	You will apparel
He/She/It will apparel	They will apparel

Apparel in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be appareling or apparelling	We will be appareling or apparelling
You will be appareling or apparelling	You will be appareling or apparelling
He/She/It will be appareling or apparelling	They will be appareling or apparelling



Apparel in Future Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I will have appareled or apparelled	We will have appareled or apparelled
You will have appareled or apparelled	You will have appareled or apparelled
He/She/It will have appareled or apparelled	I They will have appareled or apparelled

Singular	Plural
I will have been appareling or apparelling	We will have been appareling or apparelling
You will have been appareling or	You will have been appareling or
apparelling	apparelling
He/She/It will have been appareling or	They will have been appareling or
apparelling	apparelling
