Infinitive to appraise

Conjugate Appraise

Appraise in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural
I appraise We appraise
You appraise You appraise

He/She/It appraises They appraise

Appraise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am appraising We are appraising
You are appraising You are appraising
He/She/It is appraising They are appraising

Appraise in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have appraised We have appraised You have appraised You have appraised He/She/It has appraised They have appraised

Appraise in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been appraising We have been appraising You have been appraising You have been appraising He/She/It has been appraising They have been appraising

Appraise in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I appraised We appraised
You appraised You appraised
He/She/It appraised They appraised

Appraise in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was appraising We were appraising
You were appraising
He/She/It was appraising They were appraising

Appraise in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had appraised We had appraised You had appraised He/She/It had appraised They had appraised

Appraise in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been appraising We had been appraising
You had been appraising You had been appraising
He/She/It had been appraising They had been appraising

Appraise in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will appraise
You will appraise
He/She/It will appraise
They will appraise

Appraise in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be appraising We will be appraising
You will be appraising
He/She/It will be appraising They will be appraising

Appraise in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have appraised We will have appraised You will have appraised He/She/It will have appraised They will have appraised

Appraise in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been appraising
You will have been appraising
You will have been appraising
He/She/It will have been appraising
They will have been appraising
