- *A person who is learning a trade from a skilled employer, having agreed to work for a fixed period at low wages.*
- *Works for an expert to learn a trade.*
- *A beginner.*



Synonyms of "Apprentice" as a noun (11 Words)

- fledgling** A young bird that has just fledged.
*The country's **fledgling** democracy.*
- learner** Someone (especially a child) who learns (as from a teacher) or takes up knowledge or beliefs.
*A fast **learner**.*
- mentee** A person who is advised, trained, or counselled by a mentor.
- neophyte** A new convert to a religion.
*Four day cooking classes are offered to **neophytes** and experts.*
- novice** An animal, especially a racehorse, that has not yet won a major prize or reached a sufficient level of performance to qualify for important events.
*Last season as a **novice** he won three races.*
- novitiate** Someone who has entered a religious order but has not taken final vows.
- prentice** Works for an expert to learn a trade.
*A tailor's **prentice**.*

probationer A person who is serving a probationary or trial period in a job or position to which they are newly appointed.

raw recruit Informal terms for nakedness.

trainee Someone who is being trained.
Trainee solicitors.

tyro Someone new to a field or activity.

- architect** Design and configure (a program or system).
*Few software packages were **architected** with Ethernet access in mind.*
- beginner** A person just starting to learn a skill or take part in an activity.
*A **beginner**'s guide.*
- blacksmith** A farrier.
- bricklayer** A craftsman skilled in building with bricks.
- builder** Someone who contracts for and supervises construction (as of a building).
*Empire **builder**.*
- carpenter** Work as a carpenter.
*She **carpenters** and goes on archaeological digs.*

| newcomer | A person who has recently arrived in a place. <i>She s a newcomer to the area.</i> |
| novice | Someone new to a field or activity. <i>Last season as a novice he won three races.</i> |
| prentice | Works for an expert to learn a trade. <i>My brother was prenticed to a wheelwright.</i> |
| smith | Rhodesian statesman who declared independence of Zimbabwe from Great Britain (born in 1919). <i>Tin bronze was cast into ingots before being smithed into bracelets.</i> |
| sophomore | Used of the second year in United States high school or college. <i>The duo s sophomore album.</i> |
| starter | A mixture of fermenting dough reserved from an earlier batch of baking, used to initiate fermentation in fresh dough. <i>I m just a slow starter.</i> |
