Appretiate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **appretiate** We **appretiate**
You **appretiate** You **appretiate**
He/She/It **appretiates** They **appretiate**

Appretiate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am appretiating** We **are appretiating**
You **are appretiating** You **are appretiating**
He/She/It **is appretiating** They **are appretiating**

Appretiate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have appretiated** We **have appretiated**
You **have appretiated** You **have appretiated**
He/She/It **has appretiated** They **have appretiated**

Appretiate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

I **have been appretiating** We **have been appretiating**
You **have been appretiating** You **have been appretiating**
He/She/It **has been appretiating** They **have been appretiating**

Appretiate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

I **appretiated** We **appretiated**
You **appretiated** You **appretiated**
He/She/It **appretiated** They **appretiated**

Appretiate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

I was appreciating We were appreciating
You were appreciating You were appreciating
He/She/It was appreciating They were appreciating

Appreciate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

I had appreciated We had appreciated
You had appreciated You had appreciated
He/She/It had appreciated They had appreciated

Appreciate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been appreciating We had been appreciating
You had been appreciating You had been appreciating
He/She/It had been appreciating They had been appreciating

Appreciate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will appreciate We will appreciate
You will appreciate You will appreciate
He/She/It will appreciate They will appreciate

Appreciate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be appreciating We will be appreciating
You will be appreciating You will be appreciating
He/She/It will be appreciating They will be appreciating

Appreciate in Future Perfect Tense

I will have appretiated

We will have appretiated

You will have appretiated

You will have appretiated

He/She/It will have appretiated

They will have appretiated

I will have been appretiating

We will have been appretiating

You will have been appretiating

You will have been appretiating

He/She/It will have been appretiating

They will have been appretiating
