Definitions of "Apron" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “apron” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *The part of a modern theater stage between the curtain and the orchestra (i.e., in front of the curtain).*
- *A garment of cloth or leather or plastic that is tied about the waist and worn to protect your clothing.*
- *(golf) the part of the fairway leading onto the green.*
- *A hard-surfaced area on an airfield used for manoeuvring or parking aircraft.*
- *A garment similar to an apron that is worn as part of official dress, as by a bishop or Freemason.*
- *The part of the fairway leading onto the green.*
- *A protective garment worn over the front of one's clothes and tied at the back.*
- *A projecting strip of stage for playing scenes in front of the curtain.*
- *An area of asphalt where the drive of a house meets the road.*
- *A paved surface where aircraft stand while not being used.*
- *A sheet of lead worn to shield the body during an X-ray examination.*
- *An endless conveyor made of overlapping plates.*
- *An extensive outspread deposit of sediment, typically at the foot of a glacier or mountain.*

- A small area adjacent to another larger area or structure.
- The narrow strip of a boxing ring lying outside the ropes.



Synonyms of "Apron" as a noun (4 Words)

forestage The part of a modern theater stage between the curtain and the orchestra (i.e., in front of the curtain).

overall A loose protective coverall or smock worn over ordinary clothing for dirty work.

*Men in grubby blue **overalls**.*

pinafore A collarless sleeveless dress worn over a blouse or jumper.

proscenium The wall that separates the stage from the auditorium in a modern theater.

- bag** Hang loosely like an empty bag.

- basket** The quantity contained in a basket.
*A **basket** of ten currencies.*
- bathe** The act of swimming for pleasure or recreation.
*She **bathed** and bandaged my knee.*
- checked** Patterned with alternating squares of color.
*A **checked** shirt.*
- cloak** Dress in a cloak.
*They sat **cloaked** and hooded.*
- cloth** A piece of cloth for cleaning or covering something e.g a dishcloth or a tablecloth.
*A broad piece of pleated **cloth**.*

clothes	Bedclothes. A clothes shop.
clothing	A covering designed to be worn on a person's body. <i>Bring warm clothing and waterproofs.</i>
cook	A person who prepares and cooks food especially as a job or in a specified way. <i>These potatoes have to cook for 20 minutes.</i>
drape	Hanging cloth used as a blind (especially for a window). Drape a cloth.
dress	Dress or groom with elaborate care. Dress the windows.
felt	Mat together and make felt like. <i>It wasn't long before we had felted the roof making it totally watertight.</i>
holster	Put a gun into its holster. <i>He holstered the Browning before walking back.</i>
kerchief	A handkerchief.
kitchen	A set of fittings and units that are sold together and fixed in place in a kitchen. <i>A fully fitted kitchen at a bargain price.</i>
laundry	A room in a house, hotel, or institution where clothes and linen can be washed and ironed. <i>A laundry van.</i>
lined	Marked by lines or seams. <i>A sheet of lined paper.</i>
loincloth	A garment that provides covering for the loins.
packing	A charge made when delivering goods to cover the cost of packing them. <i>She finished her packing.</i>
patterned	Having patterns (especially colorful patterns). <i>Traditional rose patterned wallpaper isn't difficult to find.</i>
plaid	A cloth having a crisscross design. <i>A plaid shawl.</i>
pocket	Drive a ball into a pocket. <i>They were concentrated in pockets inside the city.</i>
pouch	Make part of a garment hang like a pouch. <i>He stopped pouching his tickets and plodded on.</i>
rack	Place in or on a rack. Rack a camera.

- robe** A robe worn especially on formal or ceremonial occasions as an indication of the wearer's rank, office or profession.
*A baby in christening **robes**.*
- sack** Put in a sack.
*Oregon intercepted five of his passes and **sacked** him five times.*
- stash** A secret store of valuables or money.
*One prisoner tried to swallow his **stash**.*
- storage** The process of storing information in a computer memory or on a magnetic tape or disk.
*A **storage** capacity of two megabytes.*
- towel** Wipe or dry with a towel.
***Towel** your hair dry.*
- zipper** Close with a zipper.
*He wore a running suit **zippered** up tight.*
