arborescent	Resembling a tree in form and branching structure. <i>Arborescent coral found off the coast of Bermuda.</i>
arboretum	A botanical garden devoted to trees.
bamboo	The hard woody stems of bamboo plants used in construction and crafts and fishing poles. <i>A section of bamboo about four feet long.</i>
batten	Secure with battens. <i>Batten ships.</i>
botanical	Relating to botany. <i>Botanical specimens.</i>
botany	All the plant life in a particular region or period. <i>The botany of China.</i>
broadleaf	A tree or plant with wide flat leaves.

bryophyte	A small flowerless green plant of the division Bryophyta, which comprises the mosses and liverworts.
dendroid	(of a plant, marine invertebrate, or structure) tree-shaped; branching.
evergreen	A person or thing of enduring freshness, success, or popularity. <i>Evergreens planted to cut off the east wind.</i>
flora	The plants of a particular region, habitat, or geological period. <i>Britain's native flora.</i>
flowering	Having a flower or bloom. <i>Winter flowering heathers.</i>
foliage	Leaf-like architectural ornament. <i>Healthy green foliage.</i>
forest	Establish a forest on previously unforested land. <i>A pine forest.</i>
garden	Work in the garden. <i>Botanical gardens.</i>
glade	An open space in a wood or forest. <i>A forest glade.</i>
grass	Cover with grass. <i>Anglers grassed 294 trout.</i>
grove	Garden consisting of a small cultivated wood without undergrowth. <i>An olive grove.</i>
herbaceous	Characteristic of a nonwoody herb or plant part.
horticultural	Of or relating to the cultivation of plants. <i>Horticultural crops.</i>
ornithology	The branch of zoology that studies birds.
plant	Put or set seeds seedlings or plants into the ground. <i>Plant bugs in the dissident's apartment.</i>
riparian	Relating to wetlands adjacent to rivers and streams. <i>The ranch's most expansive riparian habitat.</i>
shrub	A woody plant which is smaller than a tree and has several main stems arising at or near the ground.
steppe	Extensive plain without trees (associated with eastern Russia and Siberia).
tare	The weight of a motor vehicle, railroad car, or aircraft without its fuel or cargo.
tree	Stretch a shoe on a shoetree. <i>Genealogical tree.</i>

vegetation

An abnormal growth or excrescence (especially a warty excrescence on the valves of the heart).

*Pleistocene **vegetation**.*

woodland

Land covered with trees.

*Large areas of ancient **woodland**.*
