<b>arboresque</b>	Resembling a tree in form and branching structure.
<b>arborical</b>	Of or relating to or formed by trees.
<b>arboriform</b>	Resembling a tree in form and branching structure.
<b>arborous</b>	Of or relating to or formed by trees. <i>An <b>arborous</b> roof.</i>
<b>dendriform</b>	Resembling a tree in form and branching structure. <i><b>Dendriform</b> sponges.</i>
<b>dendroid</b>	(of a plant, marine invertebrate, or structure) tree-shaped; branching.
<b>dendroidal</b>	Resembling a tree in form and branching structure.



**tree-living** Inhabiting or frequenting trees.

**tree-shaped** Resembling a tree in form and branching structure.

**treelike** Resembling a tree in form and branching structure.

## Associations of "Arboreal" (30 Words)

<b>arborescent</b>	Resembling a tree in form and branching structure. <i><b>Arborescent</b> coral found off the coast of Bermuda.</i>
<b>arboretum</b>	A botanical garden devoted to trees.
<b>bamboo</b>	The hard woody stems of bamboo plants used in construction and crafts and fishing poles. <i>A section of <b>bamboo</b> about four feet long.</i>
<b>batten</b>	Secure with battens. <i><b>Batten</b> ships.</i>
<b>botanical</b>	Relating to botany. <i><b>Botanical</b> specimens.</i>
<b>botany</b>	All the plant life in a particular region or period. <i>The <b>botany</b> of China.</i>
<b>broadleaf</b>	A tree or plant with wide flat leaves.



<b>bryophyte</b>	A small flowerless green plant of the division Bryophyta, which comprises the mosses and liverworts.
<b>dendroid</b>	(of a plant, marine invertebrate, or structure) tree-shaped; branching.
<b>evergreen</b>	A person or thing of enduring freshness, success, or popularity. <b>Evergreens</b> planted to cut off the east wind.
<b>flora</b>	The plants of a particular region, habitat, or geological period. Britain's native <b>flora</b> .
<b>flowering</b>	Having a flower or bloom. Winter <b>flowering</b> heathers.
<b>foliage</b>	Leaf-like architectural ornament. Healthy green <b>foliage</b> .
<b>forest</b>	Establish a forest on previously unforested land. A pine <b>forest</b> .
<b>garden</b>	Work in the garden. Botanical <b>gardens</b> .
<b>glade</b>	An open space in a wood or forest. A forest <b>glade</b> .
<b>grass</b>	Cover with grass. Anglers <b>grassed</b> 294 trout.
<b>grove</b>	Garden consisting of a small cultivated wood without undergrowth. An olive <b>grove</b> .
<b>herbaceous</b>	Characteristic of a nonwoody herb or plant part.
<b>horticultural</b>	Of or relating to the cultivation of plants. <b>Horticultural</b> crops.
<b>ornithology</b>	The branch of zoology that studies birds.
<b>plant</b>	Put or set seeds seedlings or plants into the ground. <b>Plant</b> bugs in the dissident's apartment.
<b>riparian</b>	Relating to wetlands adjacent to rivers and streams. The ranch's most expansive <b>riparian</b> habitat.
<b>shrub</b>	A woody plant which is smaller than a tree and has several main stems arising at or near the ground.
<b>steppe</b>	Extensive plain without trees (associated with eastern Russia and Siberia).
<b>tare</b>	The weight of a motor vehicle, railroad car, or aircraft without its fuel or cargo.
<b>tree</b>	Stretch a shoe on a shoetree. Genealogical <b>tree</b> .

An abnormal growth or excrescence (especially a warty excrescence on the valves of the heart).

**woodland**

Land covered with trees.

*Large areas of ancient **woodland**.*
