<b>arboreal</b>	Inhabiting or frequenting trees. <i>Arboreal</i> rodents.
<b>aster</b>	A radiating array of microtubules associated with a centrosome in a dividing cell.
<b>botanical</b>	A substance obtained from a plant and used typically in medicinal or cosmetic products. <i>Botanical</i> specimens.
<b>botany</b>	The scientific study of the physiology, structure, genetics, ecology, distribution, classification, and economic importance of plants. <i>The botany</i> of North America.
<b>bryophyte</b>	A small flowerless green plant of the division Bryophyta, which comprises the mosses and liverworts.

<b>conservatory</b>	A greenhouse in which plants are arranged in a pleasing manner. <i>Keep plant cuttings in a frost free <b>conservatory</b> or greenhouse.</i>
<b>dendroid</b>	A graptolite (fossil marine invertebrate) of a type that formed much-branched colonies, found chiefly in the Ordovician and Silurian periods.
<b>efflorescence</b>	A powdery deposit on a surface. <i><b>Efflorescences</b> found on the sheltered undersides of shale ledges.</i>
<b>entomology</b>	The branch of zoology concerned with the study of insects.
<b>flora</b>	The plants of a particular region, habitat, or geological period. <i>The <b>flora</b> of southern California.</i>
<b>flower</b>	Induce a plant to produce flowers. <i>He wasted the <b>flower</b> of French youth on his dreams of empire.</i>
<b>flowering</b>	The time and process of budding and unfolding of blossoms. <i>The <b>flowering</b> of antebellum culture.</i>
<b><u>garden</u></b>	Work in the garden. <i>She wrote books kept journals and <b>gardened</b>.</i>
<b>grass</b>	Cover with grass. <i>Anglers <b>grassed</b> 294 trout.</i>
<b>herbaceous</b>	Denoting or relating to herbs (in the botanical sense).
<b>herbarium</b>	A room or building housing a herbarium.
<b>horticultural</b>	Relating to the art or practice of garden cultivation and management. <i><b>Horticultural</b> crops.</i>
<b>horticulture</b>	The cultivation of plants. <i>Maize and manioc <b>horticulture</b>.</i>
<b>hothouse</b>	A greenhouse in which plants are arranged in a pleasing manner. <i>The <b>hothouse</b> atmosphere of the college.</i>
<b>microbiology</b>	The branch of biology that studies microorganisms and their effects on humans.
<b>natural</b>	Existing in or in conformity with nature or the observable world neither supernatural nor magical. <i>A <b>natural</b> sweetener.</i>
<b>ornithology</b>	The branch of zoology that studies birds.
<b>plant</b>	Place a plant in the ground out of doors so it can grow especially after growing it from seed in an indoor environment. <i>Let s <b>plant</b> flowers in the garden.</i>
<b><u>specimen</u></b>	A bit of tissue or blood or urine that is taken for diagnostic purposes. <i>Carla could not help feeling a degree of reluctant admiration for this odd female <b>specimen</b>.</i>

- steppe** A large area of flat unforested grassland in south-eastern Europe or Siberia.  
Inferior in size or quality.
- stunted** *I was emotionally **stunted** and didn't know how to interact with other people.*
- tare** (chemical analysis) a counterweight used in chemical analysis; consists of an empty container that counterbalances the weight of the container holding chemicals.
- tree** Chase an animal up a tree.  
*This lot should be **treed** so that the house will be shaded in summer.*
- vegetal** Composed of vegetation or plants.  
*A **vegetal** aroma.*
- vegetation** Inactivity that is passive and monotonous, comparable to the inactivity of plant life.  
*Pleistocene **vegetation**.*
