#### Definitions of "Arcade" as a noun

According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "arcade" as a noun can have the following definitions:

- A covered passage with arches along one or both sides.
- A covered walk with shops along one or both sides.
- A series of arches supporting a wall, or set along it.
- A structure composed of a series of arches supported by columns.
- A covered passageway with shops and stalls on either side.





## Synonyms of "Arcade" as a noun (11 Words)

cloister	A courtyard with covered walks (as in religious institutions. <i>The shadowed cloisters of the convent.</i>
colonnade	A row of trees or other tall objects.
forum	A website or web page where users can post comments about a particular issue or topic and reply to other users' postings. We hope these pages act as a <b>forum</b> for debate.
<u>gallery</u>	A covered corridor (especially one extending along the wall of a building and supported with arches or columns. In the minstrels <b>gallery</b> a string orchestra plays themes from film soundtracks.
loggia	A gallery or room with one or more open sides, especially one that forms part of a house and has one side open to the garden.
peristyle	A space such as a court or porch that is surrounded or edged by a peristyle.




portico	A structure consisting of a roof supported by columns at regular intervals, typically attached as a porch to a building.
shopping centre	Searching for or buying goods or services.
shopping complex	The commodities purchased from storeswomen carrying home shopping didn't give me a second glance.
shopping precinct	The commodities purchased from storeswomen carrying home shopping didn't give me a second glance.
stoa	The great hall in Athens in which the ancient Greek philosopher Zeno

# Associations of "Arcade" (30 Words)

<u>aisle</u>	Part of a church divided laterally from the nave proper by rows of pillars or columns. <i>The tiled roof over the south aisle</i> .
<u>amenities</u>	Things that make you comfortable and at ease.
bingo	A game in which players mark off numbers on cards as the numbers are drawn randomly by a caller, the winner being the first person to mark off all their numbers. <i>A bingo</i> hall.
classic	An artist who has created classic works. A <b>classic</b> al ballet.
colonnade	A row of evenly spaced columns supporting a roof, an entablature, or arches.
convivial	(of an atmosphere or event) friendly, lively, and enjoyable. A <b>convivial</b> atmosphere at the reunion.
dancer	A performer who dances professionally. She thought he would become a ballet <b>dancer</b> .
entertainment	The action of providing or being provided with amusement or enjoyment. <i>A theatrical entertainment.</i>
<u>exhibition</u>	A display or demonstration of a skill. <i>He never lent his treasures out for <b>exhibition</b>.</i>
expo	A large international exhibition.
foyer	An entrance hall in a house or flat. The <b>foyer</b> of the concert hall.
<u>gallery</u>	The highest balcony in a theatre, containing the cheapest seats. In the minstrels <b>gallery</b> a string orchestra plays themes from film soundtracks.
game	A score of 100 points for tricks bid and made the best of three games constituting a rubber. Rooks attempted to raise his <b>game</b> to another level.
gangway	A passage between rows of seats, especially in a theatre or aircraft.
<u>hall</u>	A university building containing rooms for students to live in. <i>Halls of learning.</i>
<u>hobby</u>	An auxiliary activity. Her hobbies are reading and gardening.
infotainment	A film or TV program presenting the facts about a person or event.



<u>leisure</u>	Freedom to choose a pastime or enjoyable activity. <i>He lacked the <b>leisure</b> for golf.</i>
monumental	Of outstanding significance. Additional details are found in <b>monumental</b> inscriptions.
narrow	A narrow channel connecting two larger areas of water. Won by a <b>narrow</b> margin.
nave	The central part of a church building, intended to accommodate most of the congregation. In traditional Western churches it is rectangular, separated from the chancel by a step or rail, and from adjacent aisles by pillars.
<u>passage</u>	Subject a strain of microorganisms or cells to a passage. The outward <b>passage</b> took 10 days.
pastime	An activity that someone does regularly for enjoyment rather than work; a hobby. <i>His favourite <b>pastime</b>s were shooting and golf.</i>
purchase	Something acquired by purchase. <i>He could get no <b>purchase</b> on the situation.</i>
recreation	Activity that refreshes and recreates; activity that renews your health and spirits by enjoyment and relaxation. <i>Sport and recreation facilities.</i>
roof	Function as the roof of. A thatched <b>roof</b> .
shopping	The commodities purchased from storeswomen carrying home shopping didn t give me a second glance. A bag of <b>shopping</b> .
<u>sociable</u>	A tricycle with two seats side by side. A <b>sociable</b> conversation.
<u>theater</u>	The art of writing and producing plays. <i>He served in the Vietnam <b>theater</b> for three years.</i>
<u>walkway</u>	A path set aside for walking.
