Arch as a Noun

Definitions of "Arch" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “arch” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A curved bony structure supporting or enclosing organs (especially the inner sides of the feet).*
- *(architecture) a masonry construction (usually curved) for spanning an opening and supporting the weight above it.*
- *An arch forming a monument or ornamental feature.*
- *A passageway under a curved masonry construction.*
- *A masonry construction (usually curved) for spanning an opening and supporting the weight above it.*

- A curved symmetrical structure spanning an opening and typically supporting the weight of a bridge, roof, or wall above it.
- A shape resembling an arch.
- A curved shape in the vertical plane that spans an opening.
- The inner side of the foot.



Synonyms of "Arch" as a noun (10 Words)

- arc** A shape or structure resembling an arc.
*The point where a tangential line touches the **arc** of a circle.*
- archway** A passageway under a curved masonry construction.
- bend** A kind of knot used to join two ropes together or to tie a rope to another object
e.g. a carrick bend.
*Make a **bend** in the wire.*
- bow** A decorative ribbon tied in a bow.
*He pointed the **bow** of the boat toward the finish line.*

curve A pitch of a baseball that is thrown with spin so that its path curves as it approaches the batter.

*He relies on a couple of **curves** and a modest fastball.*

dome A thing shaped like a dome.

*The **dome** of St Paul s Cathedral.*

semicircle A set of objects arranged in a semicircle.

*Chairs were in a **semicircle** round the hearth.*

span The wingspan of an aircraft or a bird.

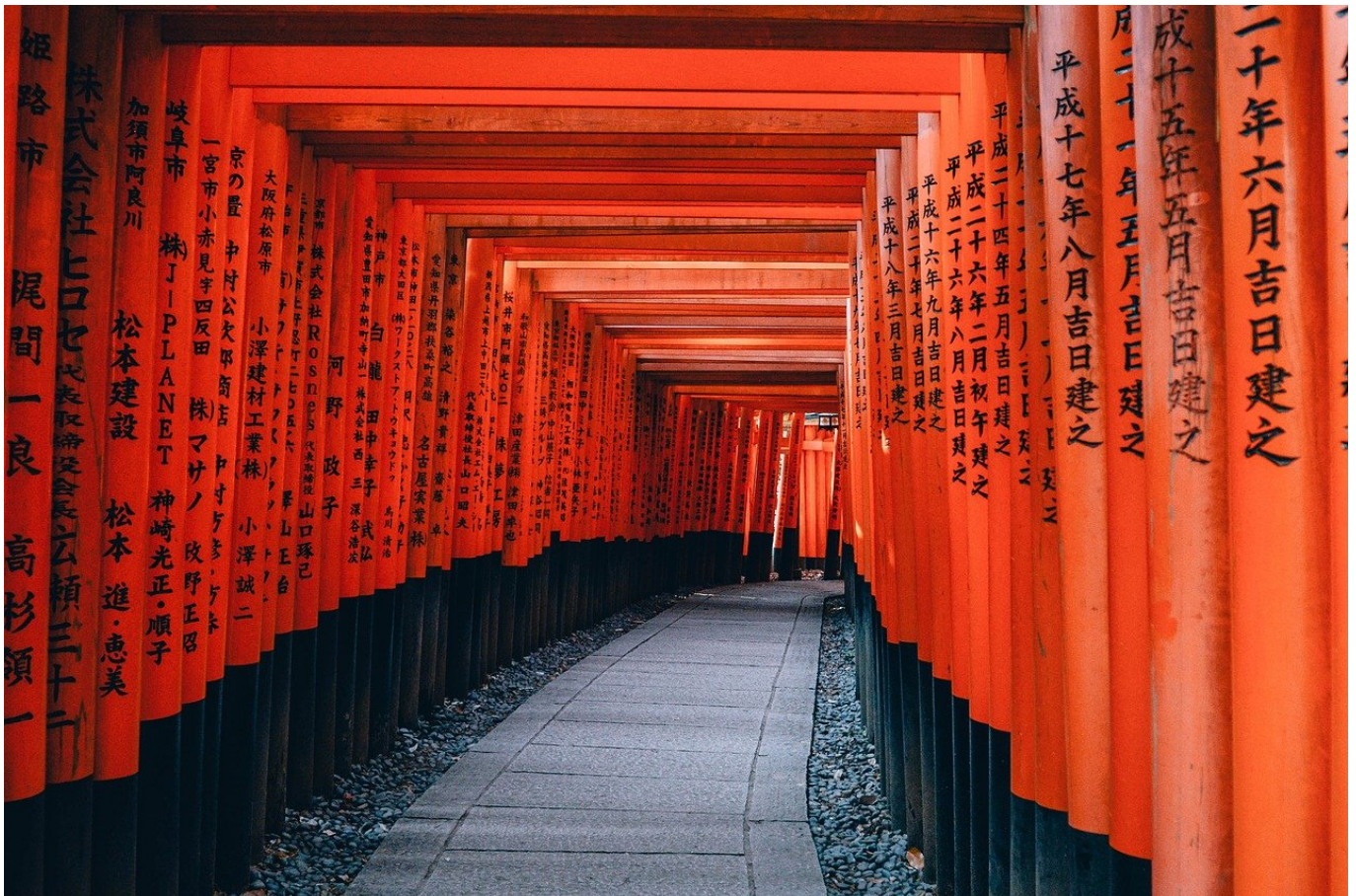
*A warehouse with a clear **span** of 28 feet.*

sweep An act of sweeping something with a brush.

*She asked if I wanted a membrane **sweep** to get labour going.*

vault A secure room in a bank in which valuables are stored.

*A Gothic ribbed **vault**.*



Usage Examples of "Arch" as a noun

- *The muscles in the arch of my right foot suddenly seized up.*

- *The delicate arch of his eyebrows.*
- *A triumphal arch.*
- *They built a triumphal arch to memorialize their victory.*

curve Extend in curves and turns.
*The road **curved** sharply.*

- *Her eyebrows arched in surprise.*

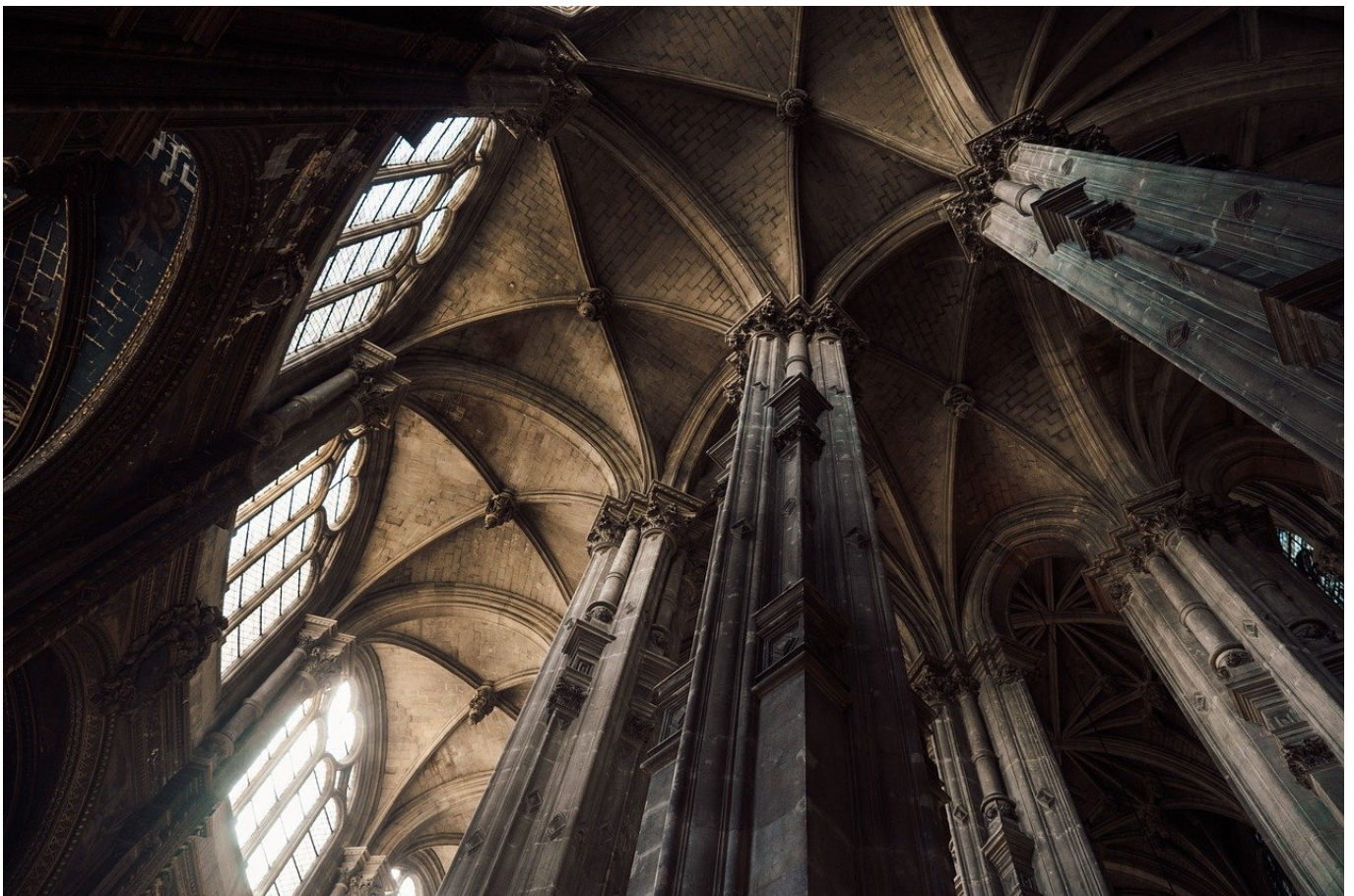


Arch as an Adjective

- *(used of behavior or attitude) characteristic of those who treat others with condescension.*
- *Naughtily or annoyingly playful.*
- *Expert in skulduggery.*
- *Characteristic of those who treat others with condescension.*

condescending	Characteristic of those who treat others with condescension. A condescending smile.
impish	Naughtily or annoyingly playful. <i>Teasing and worrying with impish laughter.</i>
implike	Naughtily or annoyingly playful.
mischievous	(of an action or statement) causing or intended to cause harm or trouble. A mischievous grin.
patronising	(used of behavior or attitude) characteristic of those who treat others with condescension.
patronizing	Apparently kind or helpful but betraying a feeling of superiority; condescending. <i>We both occasionally experienced patronizing attitudes from staff.</i>
pixilated	Very drunk.
prankish	Showing a fondness for practical jokes or mischievous acts. <i>Flashes of prankish humour.</i>
puckish	Playful, especially in a mischievous way. A puckish sense of humour.
wicked	Intensely or extremely bad or unpleasant in degree or quality. A wicked sense of humour.

*The tower is made of steel **girders** criss crossed to make it stronger.*
- gracefully** In a gracious or graceful manner.
*I will **gracefully** bow out of the discussion.*
- harness** Put a harness.
*The horse was **harnessed** to two long shafts.*
- highway** A main road, especially one connecting major towns or cities.
*A six lane **highway**.*
- horseshoe** A horseshoe or a representation of one regarded as bringing good luck.
*A **horseshoe** bend.*
- nail** Fasten with a nail or nails.
***Nail** the board onto the wall.*

overpass	Bridge formed by the upper level of a crossing of two highways at different levels. <i>Did not its sublimity overpass a little the bounds of the ridiculous.</i>
parapet	A protective wall or earth defence along the top of a trench or other place of concealment for troops. <i>The sandbags that made up the parapet had been blown away and the wall of the trench had caved in.</i>
puckish	Naughtily or annoyingly playful. <i>A puckish sense of humour.</i>
railing	A barrier consisting of a horizontal bar and supports. <i>Wrought iron railings.</i>
railway	A network of tracks with the trains, organization, and personnel required for its working. <i>The carriage of freight on the railways.</i>
rein	Control and direct with or as if by reins. <i>He reined in his horses in front of the post office.</i>
roof	Function as the roof of. <i>While you live under my roof you re not going to have a tattoo.</i>
rotunda	A round building or room, especially one with a dome. <i>A rotunda that exits on four roads into Greater Manila.</i>
shaped	Shaped to fit by or as if by altering the contours of a pliable mass as by work or effort. <i>Her oval shaped face.</i>
toe	The part of an item of footwear that covers a person s toes. <i>The contrast potential of the printing is indicated by the steepness of the curve from shoulder to toe.</i>
trestle	Sawhorses used in pairs to support a horizontal tabletop.
