
Definitions of "Arch" as a noun

- A curved bony structure supporting or enclosing organs (especially the inner sides of the feet.
- (architecture) a masonry construction (usually curved) for spanning an opening and supporting the weight above it.
- An arch forming a monument or ornamental feature.
- A passageway under a curved masonry construction.
- A masonry construction (usually curved) for spanning an opening and supporting the weight above it.



- A curved symmetrical structure spanning an opening and typically supporting the weight of a bridge, roof, or wall above it.
- A shape resembling an arch.
- A curved shape in the vertical plane that spans an opening.
- The inner side of the foot.

- They built a triumphal arch to memorialize their victory.




Arch as a Verb

Play on a stringed instrument with a bow. **bow**





- Her eyebrows arched in surprise.







Flashes of **prankish** humour.


puckish Playful, especially in a mischievous way.
