## Associations of "Archipelago" (30 Words)

<b>atoll</b>	An island consisting of a circular coral reef surrounding a lagoon.
<b>bay</b>	Of a moderate reddish-brown color. <i>He opened the bomb <b>bay</b>.</i>
<b>boreal</b>	Relating to or denoting the second climatic stage of the postglacial period in northern Europe between the Preboreal and Atlantic stages about 9 000 to 7 500 years ago marked by a warm dry climate. <i>Northern <b>boreal</b> forest.</i>
<b>coast</b>	Sail along the coast especially in order to carry cargo. <i>They sailed further up the <b>coast</b>.</i>
<b>coastal</b>	Located on or near or bordering on a coast. <i><b>Coastal</b> erosion.</i>
<b>coral</b>	The pinkish red colour of red coral. <i><b>Coral</b> beads.</i>
<b>east</b>	A location in the eastern part of a country region or city. <i>The river rises <b>east</b> of Brentford.</i>
<b>foreshore</b>	The part of a shore between high- and low-water marks, or between the water and cultivated or developed land.
<b>gulf</b>	A deep inlet of the sea almost surrounded by land, with a narrow mouth. <i>The widening <b>gulf</b> between the rich and the poor.</i>
<b>island</b>	A thing regarded as resembling an island especially in being isolated detached or surrounded in some way. <i>This <b>island</b> nation.</i>
<b>isle</b>	A small island. <i>Crusoe s fabled <b>isle</b>.</i>
<b>islet</b>	A small island.
<b>kelp</b>	The calcined ashes of seaweed, used as a source of various salts. <i>There are several <b>kelps</b> found in the lower zones.</i>

<b>lagoon</b>	A small freshwater lake near a larger lake or river.
<b>littoral</b>	The littoral zone. <i>Irrigated regions of the Mediterranean <b>littoral</b>.</i>
<b>maritime</b>	Connected with the sea, especially in relation to seaborne trade or naval matters. <i>Two species of Diptera occur in the <b>maritime</b> Antarctic.</i>
<b>nautical</b>	Relating to or involving ships or shipping or navigation or seamen. <i><b>Nautical</b> charts.</i>
<b>north</b>	The northern part of the world or of a specified country region or town. <i>They earn more up <b>north</b>.</i>
<b>northernmost</b>	Situated furthest to the north. <i>Alaska is our <b>northernmost</b> state.</i>
<b><u>ocean</u></b>	The sea. <i>They scramble across the beach to the <b>ocean</b> and plunge into the surf.</i>
<b>offshore</b>	Of or derived from a foreign country. <i>Weather forecasters say the cyclone should move <b>offshore</b>.</i>
<b>peninsula</b>	A piece of land almost surrounded by water or projecting out into a body of water.
<b>peninsular</b>	Of or forming or resembling a peninsula. <i>The counties of <b>peninsular</b> Florida.</i>
<b>reef</b>	Reduce a sail by taking in a reef. <i><b>Reef</b> the sailboat s mast.</i>
<b><u>region</u></b>	The approximate amount of something usually used prepositionally as in in the region of. <i>A major wine producing <b>region</b>.</i>
<b>seabed</b>	The ground under the sea; the ocean floor.
<b>seashore</b>	The shore of a sea or ocean.
<b>southeast</b>	A location in the southeastern part of a country region or city. <i><b>Southeasterly</b> breezes.</i>
<b>southern</b>	Situated in or oriented toward the south. <i>The warm <b>southern</b> wind.</i>
<b>zone</b>	Divide into or assign to zones. <i>The land is <b>zoned</b> for housing.</i>
