Associations of "Archipelago" (30 Words)

atoll	An island consisting of a circular coral reef surrounding a lagoon.
bay	Of a moderate reddish-brown color. <i>He opened the bomb bay.</i>
boreal	Relating to or denoting the second climatic stage of the postglacial period in northern Europe between the Preboreal and Atlantic stages about 9 000 to 7 500 years ago marked by a warm dry climate. <i>Northern boreal forest.</i>
coast	Sail along the coast especially in order to carry cargo. <i>They sailed further up the coast.</i>
coastal	Located on or near or bordering on a coast. <i>Coastal erosion.</i>
coral	The pinkish red colour of red coral. <i>Coral beads.</i>
east	A location in the eastern part of a country region or city. <i>The river rises east of Brentford.</i>
foreshore	The part of a shore between high- and low-water marks, or between the water and cultivated or developed land.
gulf	A deep inlet of the sea almost surrounded by land, with a narrow mouth. <i>The widening gulf between the rich and the poor.</i>
island	A thing regarded as resembling an island especially in being isolated detached or surrounded in some way. <i>This island nation.</i>
isle	A small island. <i>Crusoe s fabled isle.</i>
islet	A small island.
kelp	The calcined ashes of seaweed, used as a source of various salts. <i>There are several kelps found in the lower zones.</i>

lagoon	A small freshwater lake near a larger lake or river.
littoral	The littoral zone. <i>Irrigated regions of the Mediterranean littoral.</i>
maritime	Connected with the sea, especially in relation to seaborne trade or naval matters. <i>Two species of Diptera occur in the maritime Antarctic.</i>
nautical	Relating to or involving ships or shipping or navigation or seamen. <i>Nautical charts.</i>
north	The northern part of the world or of a specified country region or town. <i>They earn more up north.</i>
northernmost	Situated furthest to the north. <i>Alaska is our northernmost state.</i>
<u>ocean</u>	The sea. <i>They scramble across the beach to the ocean and plunge into the surf.</i>
offshore	Of or derived from a foreign country. <i>Weather forecasters say the cyclone should move offshore.</i>
peninsula	A piece of land almost surrounded by water or projecting out into a body of water.
peninsular	Of or forming or resembling a peninsula. <i>The counties of peninsular Florida.</i>
reef	Reduce a sail by taking in a reef. <i>Reef the sailboat s mast.</i>
<u>region</u>	The approximate amount of something usually used prepositionally as in in the region of. <i>A major wine producing region.</i>
seabed	The ground under the sea; the ocean floor.
seashore	The shore of a sea or ocean.
southeast	A location in the southeastern part of a country region or city. <i>Southeasterly breezes.</i>
southern	Situated in or oriented toward the south. <i>The warm southern wind.</i>
zone	Divide into or assign to zones. <i>The land is zoned for housing.</i>
