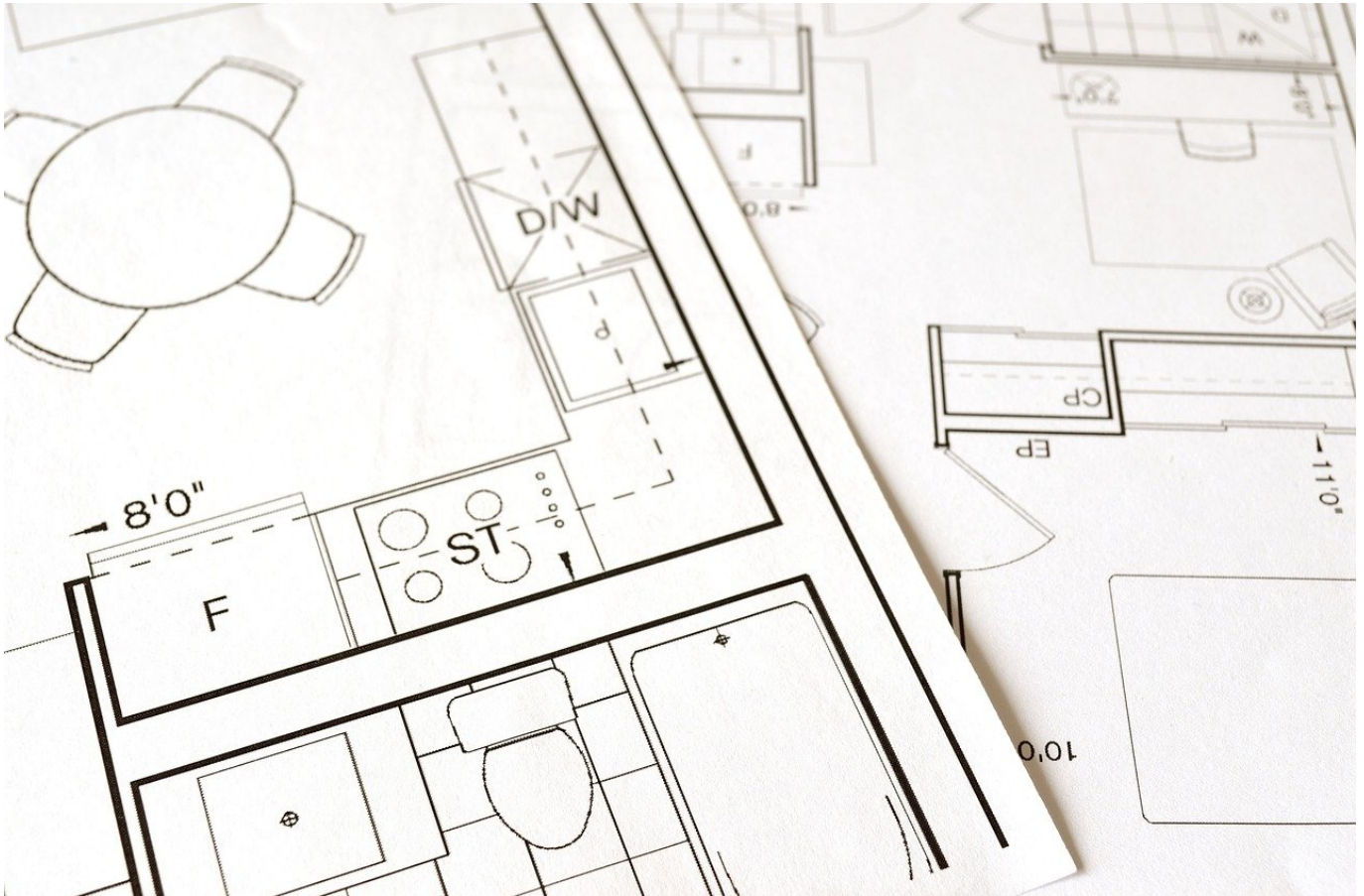

### Definitions of "Architect" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “architect” as a noun can have the following definitions:

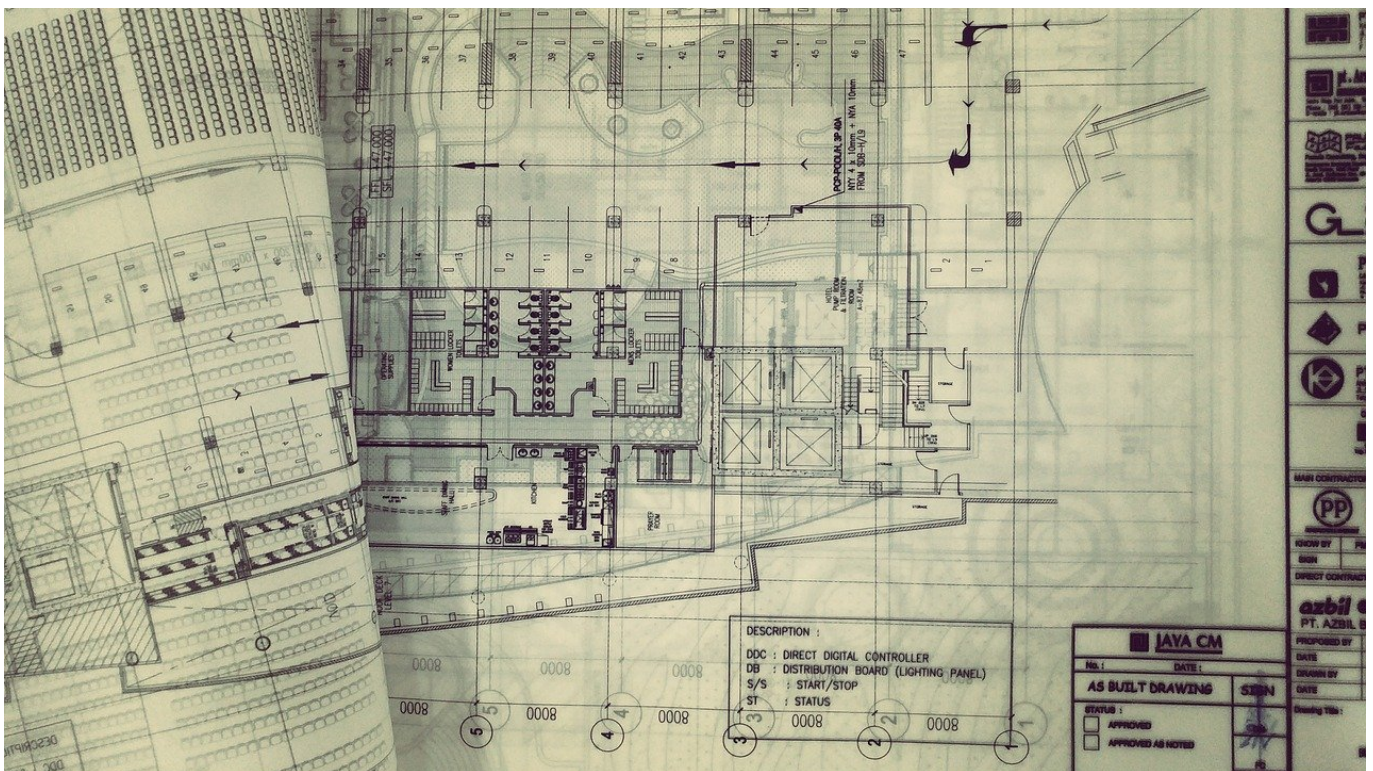
- *A person who is qualified to design buildings and to plan and supervise their construction.*
- *A person who designs hardware, software, or networking applications and services of a specified type for a business or other organization.*
- *Someone who creates plans to be used in making something (such as buildings).*
- *A person who is responsible for inventing or realizing a particular idea or project.*



## Synonyms of "Architect" as a noun (14 Words)

<b>author</b>	The writings produced by a particular author. <i>The <b>authors</b> of the peace plan.</i>
<b><u>builder</u></b>	A person who creates a business or who organizes and develops a country. <i>Empire <b>builder</b>.</i>
<b>building consultant</b>	The act of constructing something.
<b><u>creator</u></b>	Terms referring to the Judeo-Christian God. <i>James Bond s <b>creator</b> Ian Fleming.</i>
<b><u>designer</u></b>	Someone who specializes in graphic design. <i>A fashion <b>designer</b>.</i>
<b>draughtsman</b>	A person who makes detailed technical plans or drawings.
<b>father</b>	A male parent also used as a term of address to your father. <i>Keep the faith of our fore<b>fathers</b>.</i>

- founder** A person who manufactures articles of cast metal; the owner or operator of a foundry.  
*An iron **founder**.*
- founding father** Food and lodging provided in addition to money.
- instigator** A person who initiates a course of action.  
*Any **instigators** of violence will be punished.*
- mother** A woman who has given birth to a child also used as a term of address to your mother.  
*A **mother** of three.*
- originator** Someone who creates new things.  
*Wegener was the **originator** of the theory of continental drift.*
- planner** A list or chart with information that is an aid to planning.  
*Economic **planners**.*
- prime mover** The second canonical hour; about 6 a.m.



## Usage Examples of "Architect" as a noun

- *The architects of the reform programme.*

- *The great Norman architect of Durham Cathedral.*

<b>builder</b>	Someone who contracts for and supervises construction (as of a building). <i>Empire <b>builder</b>.</i>
<b>carpenter</b>	Do the work of a carpenter. <i>She <b>carpenters</b> and goes on archaeological digs.</i>
<b>design</b>	Create the design for create or execute in an artistic or highly skilled manner. <i>He contributed to the <b>design</b> of a new instrument.</i>
<b>designer</b>	Made or designed by a famous and prestigious fashion designer. <i>He s one of the world s leading car <b>designers</b>.</i>
<b>diagram</b>	Schedule the operations of a locomotive or train according to a diagram. <i>The experiment is <b>diagrammed</b> on page fourteen.</i>
<b>engineer</b>	A person qualified in a branch of engineering especially as a professional. <i>An aeronautical <b>engineer</b>.</i>
<b>engraver</b>	A tool or machine used to cut or carve text or designs on the surface of hard objects. <i>A laser <b>engraver</b> is used for some fine details.</i>
<b>lithograph</b>	Print by lithography. <i>He <b>lithographed</b> the diploma leaving only two blanks one for the name of the recipient and the other for the date.</i>
<b>modernist</b>	An artist who makes a deliberate break with previous styles. <i>James Joyce and other 20th century <b>modernists</b>.</i>
<b>muralist</b>	A painter of murals.
<b>painter</b>	Large American feline resembling a lion. <i>A self employed <b>painter</b> and decorator.</i>
<b>panther</b>	A leopard, especially a black one.
<b>portrait</b>	A representation or impression of someone or something in language or on film or television. <i>A <b>portrait</b> of George III.</i>
<b>rebuild</b>	An instance of rebuilding. <i>The Trust have recognized the hard work of all who were involved in this daunting <b>rebuild</b>.</i>
<b>recast</b>	Cast again, in a different role. <i>He was <b>recast</b> as Iago.</i>
<b>reconstruct</b>	Cause somebody to adapt or reform socially or politically. <i>Later emperors <b>reconstructed</b> the army.</i>
<b>redesign</b>	The action or process of redesigning something. <i>It was achieved by the <b>redesign</b> of the product.</i>

- remodel** Cast or model anew.  
*The station was **remodelled** and enlarged in 1927.*
- reshape** Shape again or shape differently.  
*The new foreign minister **reshaped** the foreign policy of his country.*
- schematic** In technical contexts a schematic diagram in particular of an electric or electronic circuit.  
*Only a few manufacturers provide **schematics** with their gear.*
- sculptor** An artist who creates sculptures.
- silversmith** Someone who makes or repairs articles of silver.
- smith** Someone who works at something specified.  
*Tin bronze was cast into ingots before being **smithed** into bracelets.*
- tanner** A lotion or cream designed to promote the development of a suntan or produce a similar skin colour artificially.  
*Skincare companies are coming to the rescue of consumers with sunless **tanners**.*
- wright** Influential United States architect (1869-1959).
