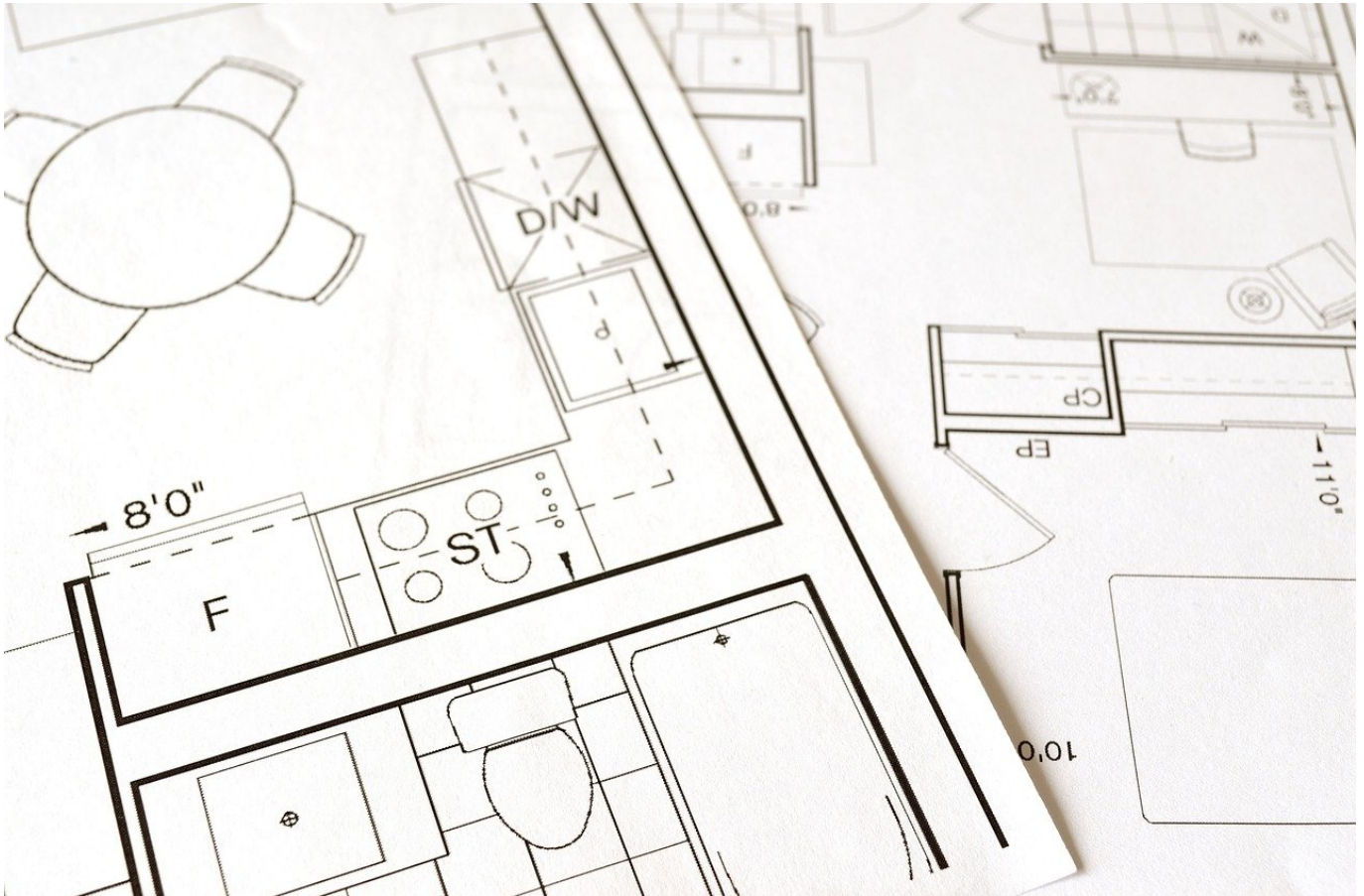

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “architect” as a noun can have the following definitions:

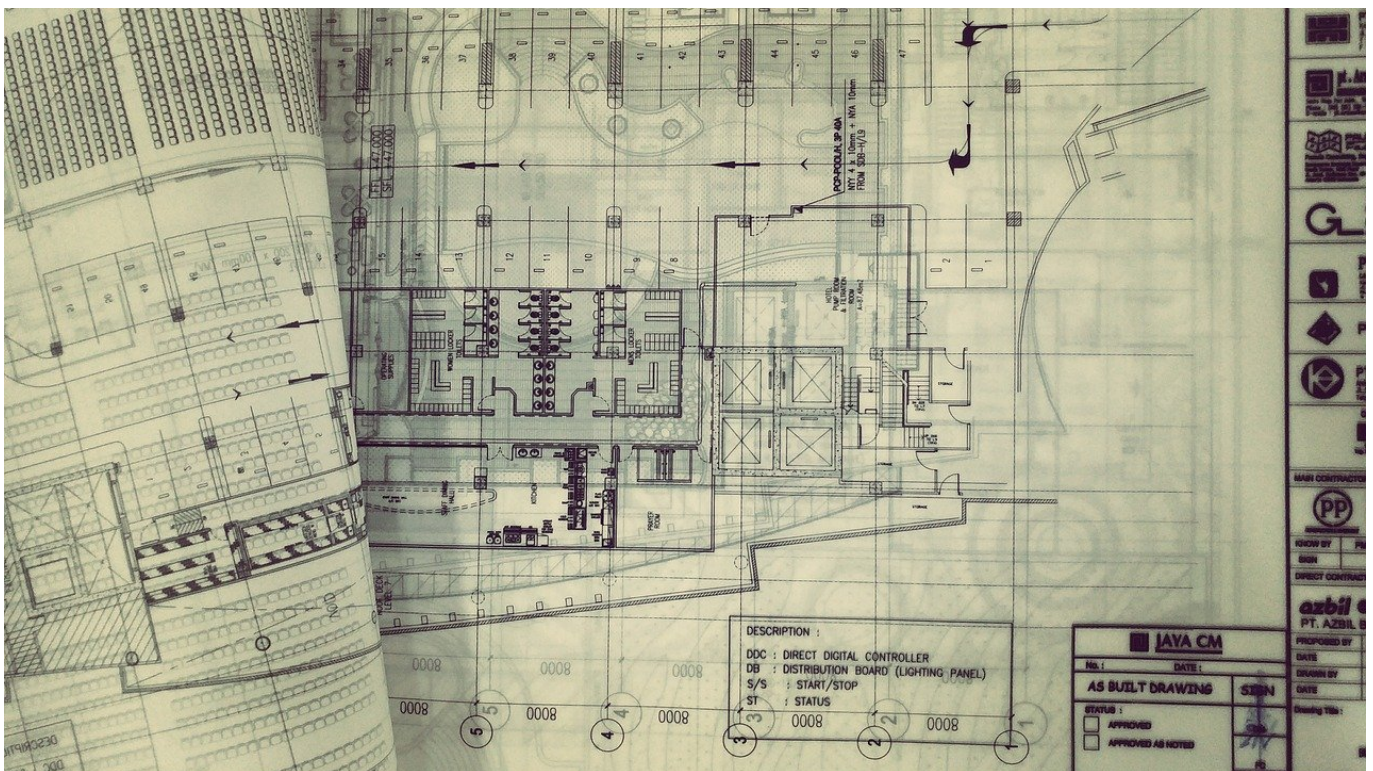
- *A person who is qualified to design buildings and to plan and supervise their construction.*
- *A person who designs hardware, software, or networking applications and services of a specified type for a business or other organization.*
- *Someone who creates plans to be used in making something (such as buildings).*
- *A person who is responsible for inventing or realizing a particular idea or project.*



Synonyms of "Architect" as a noun (14 Words)

author	The writings produced by a particular author. <i>The authors of the peace plan.</i>
<u>builder</u>	A person who creates a business or who organizes and develops a country. <i>Empire builder.</i>
building consultant	The act of constructing something.
<u>creator</u>	Terms referring to the Judeo-Christian God. <i>James Bond s creator Ian Fleming.</i>
<u>designer</u>	Someone who specializes in graphic design. <i>A fashion designer.</i>
draughtsman	A person who makes detailed technical plans or drawings.
father	A male parent also used as a term of address to your father. <i>Keep the faith of our forefathers.</i>

- founder** A person who manufactures articles of cast metal; the owner or operator of a foundry.
*An iron **founder**.*
- founding father** Food and lodging provided in addition to money.
- instigator** A person who initiates a course of action.
*Any **instigators** of violence will be punished.*
- mother** A woman who has given birth to a child also used as a term of address to your mother.
*A **mother** of three.*
- originator** Someone who creates new things.
*Wegener was the **originator** of the theory of continental drift.*
- planner** A list or chart with information that is an aid to planning.
*Economic **planners**.*
- prime mover** The second canonical hour; about 6 a.m.

- *The great Norman architect of Durham Cathedral.*

- bricklayer** A person whose job is to build walls, houses, and other structures with bricks.

builder	Someone who contracts for and supervises construction (as of a building). <i>Empire builder.</i>
carpenter	Do the work of a carpenter. <i>She carpenters and goes on archaeological digs.</i>
design	Create the design for create or execute in an artistic or highly skilled manner. <i>He contributed to the design of a new instrument.</i>
designer	Made or designed by a famous and prestigious fashion designer. <i>He s one of the world s leading car designers.</i>
diagram	Schedule the operations of a locomotive or train according to a diagram. <i>The experiment is diagrammed on page fourteen.</i>
engineer	A person qualified in a branch of engineering especially as a professional. <i>An aeronautical engineer.</i>
engraver	A tool or machine used to cut or carve text or designs on the surface of hard objects. <i>A laser engraver is used for some fine details.</i>
lithograph	Print by lithography. <i>He lithographed the diploma leaving only two blanks one for the name of the recipient and the other for the date.</i>
modernist	An artist who makes a deliberate break with previous styles. <i>James Joyce and other 20th century modernists.</i>
muralist	A painter of murals.
painter	Large American feline resembling a lion. <i>A self employed painter and decorator.</i>
panther	A leopard, especially a black one.
portrait	A representation or impression of someone or something in language or on film or television. <i>A portrait of George III.</i>
rebuild	An instance of rebuilding. <i>The Trust have recognized the hard work of all who were involved in this daunting rebuild.</i>
recast	Cast again, in a different role. <i>He was recast as Iago.</i>
reconstruct	Cause somebody to adapt or reform socially or politically. <i>Later emperors reconstructed the army.</i>
redesign	The action or process of redesigning something. <i>It was achieved by the redesign of the product.</i>

- remodel** Cast or model anew.
*The station was **remodelled** and enlarged in 1927.*
- reshape** Shape again or shape differently.
*The new foreign minister **reshaped** the foreign policy of his country.*
- schematic** In technical contexts a schematic diagram in particular of an electric or electronic circuit.
*Only a few manufacturers provide **schematics** with their gear.*
- sculptor** An artist who creates sculptures.
- silversmith** Someone who makes or repairs articles of silver.
- smith** Someone who works at something specified.
*Tin bronze was cast into ingots before being **smithed** into bracelets.*
- tanner** A lotion or cream designed to promote the development of a suntan or produce a similar skin colour artificially.
*Skincare companies are coming to the rescue of consumers with sunless **tanners**.*
- wright** Influential United States architect (1869-1959).
