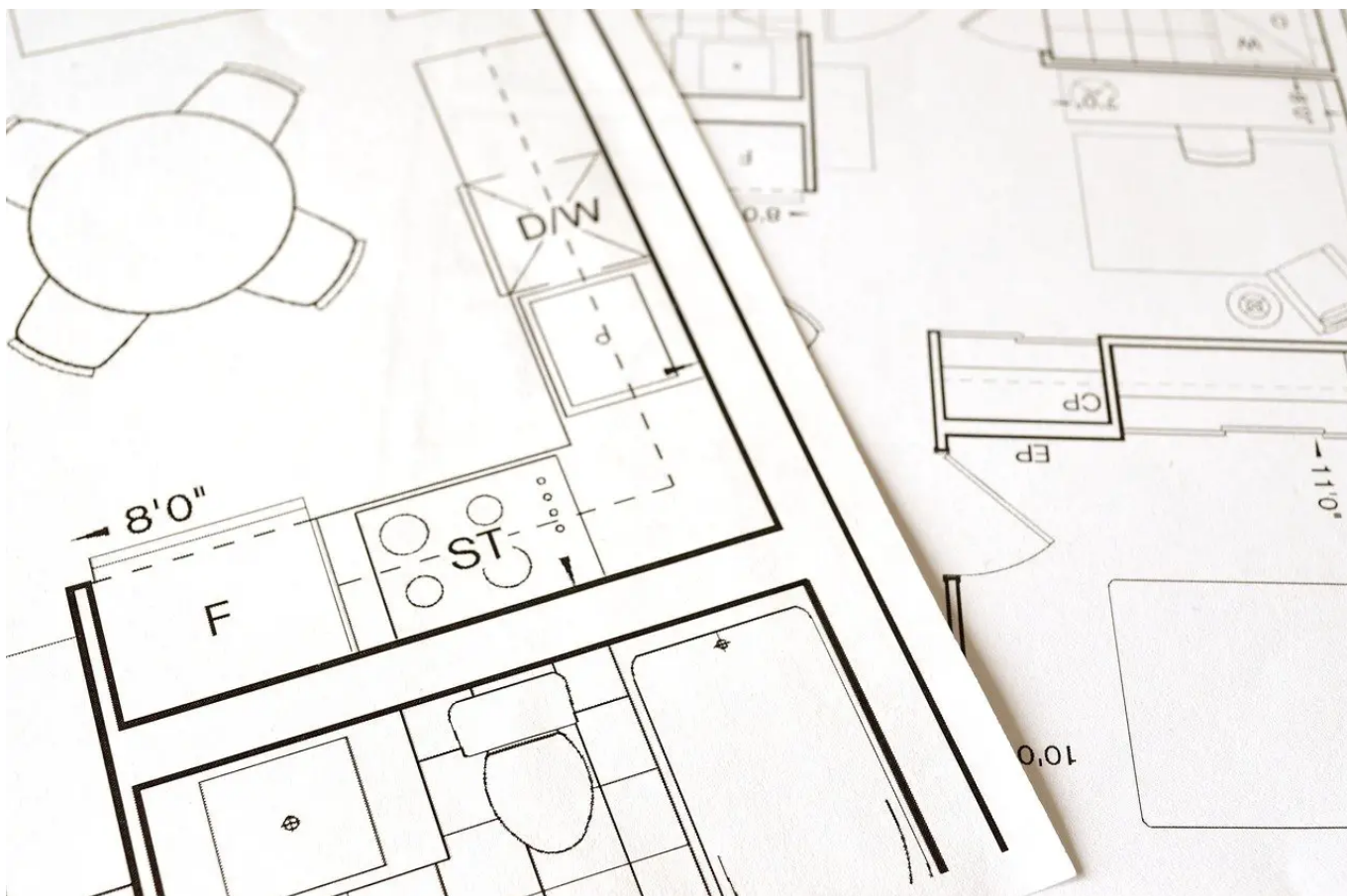

- *A person who is qualified to design buildings and to plan and supervise their construction.*
- *A person who designs hardware, software, or networking applications and services of a specified type for a business or other organization.*
- *Someone who creates plans to be used in making something (such as buildings.*
- *A person who is responsible for inventing or realizing a particular idea or project.*

builder

A person who creates a business or who organizes and develops a country.
*Empire **builder**.*

building consultant The act of constructing something.

creator

Terms referring to the Judeo-Christian God.
*James Bond's **creator** Ian Fleming.*

designer

Someone who specializes in graphic design.
*A fashion **designer**.*

draughtsman

A person who makes detailed technical plans or drawings.

father

A male parent also used as a term of address to your father.
*Keep the faith of our fore**fathers**.*

founder

A person who manufactures articles of cast metal; the owner or operator of a foundry.

An iron **founder**.

founding father

Food and lodging provided in addition to money.

instigator

A person who initiates a course of action.

Any **instigators** of violence will be punished.

mother

A woman who has given birth to a child also used as a term of address to your mother.

A **mother** of three.

originator

Someone who creates new things.

Wegener was the **originator** of the theory of continental drift.

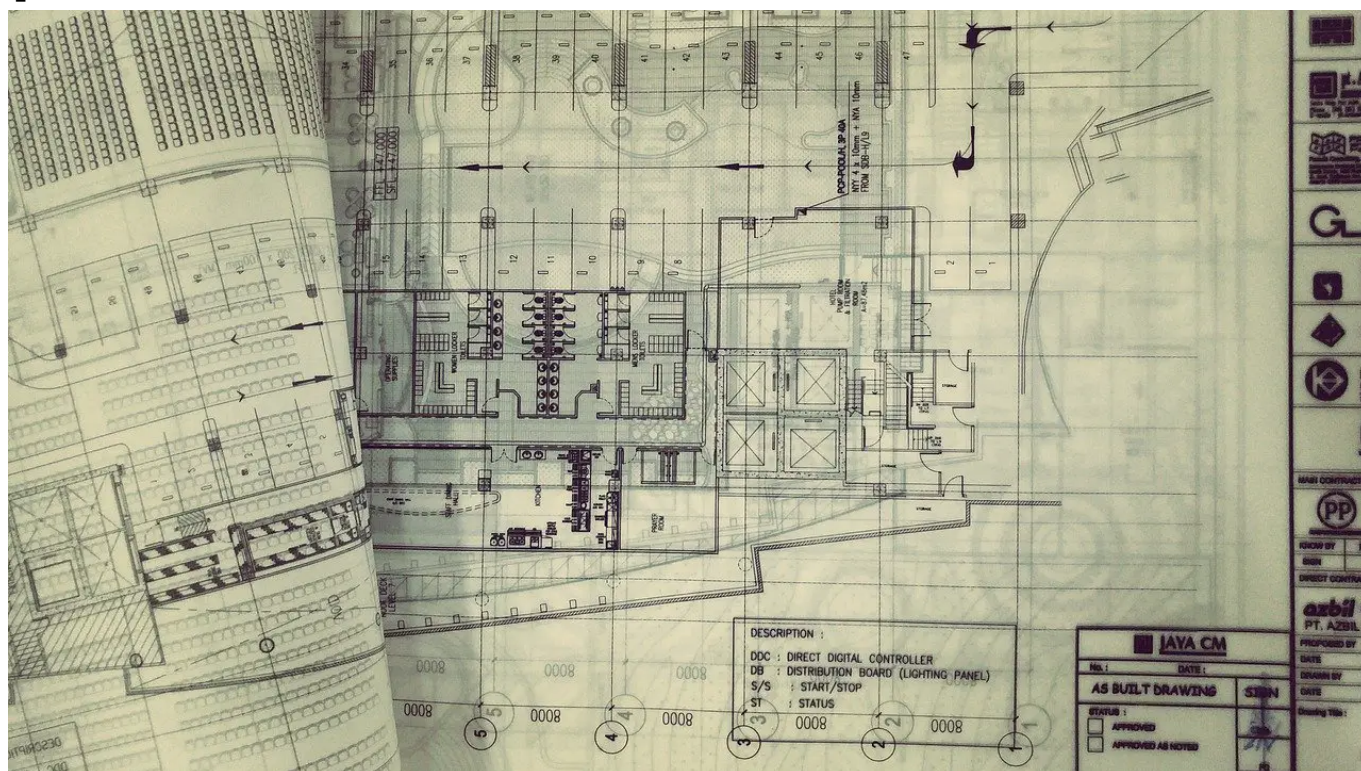
planner

A list or chart with information that is an aid to planning.

Economic **planners**.

prime mover

The second canonical hour; about 6 a.m.



Usage Examples of "Architect" as a noun

- John was indisputably the architect of his own misfortune.
- The architects of the reform programme.

- *The great Norman architect of Durham Cathedral.*
- *We are seeking an experienced software architect to join our scientific computing team.*



Associations of "Architect" (30 Words)

<u>architecture</u>	The discipline dealing with the principles of design and construction and ornamentation of fine buildings. <i>The chemical architecture of the human brain.</i>
<u>atelier</u>	A studio especially for an artist or designer.
<u>blacksmith</u>	A farrier.
<u>blueprint</u>	Make a blueprint of. A blueprint for a house.
bricklayer	A person whose job is to build walls, houses, and other structures with bricks.

<u>builder</u>	Someone who contracts for and supervises construction (as of a building). <i>Empire builder.</i>
<u>carpenter</u>	Do the work of a carpenter. <i>She carpenters and goes on archaeological digs.</i>
design	Create the design for create or execute in an artistic or highly skilled manner. <i>He contributed to the design of a new instrument.</i>
<u>designer</u>	Made or designed by a famous and prestigious fashion designer. <i>He s one of the world s leading car designers.</i>
<u>diagram</u>	Schedule the operations of a locomotive or train according to a diagram. <i>The experiment is diagrammed on page fourteen.</i>
<u>engineer</u>	A person qualified in a branch of engineering especially as a professional. <i>An aeronautical engineer.</i>
engraver	A tool or machine used to cut or carve text or designs on the surface of hard objects. <i>A laser engraver is used for some fine details.</i>
lithograph	Print by lithography. <i>He lithographed the diploma leaving only two blanks one for the name of the recipient and the other for the date.</i>
modernist	An artist who makes a deliberate break with previous styles. <i>James Joyce and other 20th century modernists.</i>
muralist	A painter of murals.
painter	Large American feline resembling a lion. <i>A self employed painter and decorator.</i>
panther	A leopard, especially a black one.
<u>portrait</u>	A representation or impression of someone or something in language or on film or television. <i>A portrait of George III.</i>
<u>rebuild</u>	An instance of rebuilding. <i>The Trust have recognized the hard work of all who were involved in this daunting rebuild.</i>
recast	Cast again, in a different role. <i>He was recast as Iago.</i>
<u>reconstruct</u>	Cause somebody to adapt or reform socially or politically. <i>Later emperors reconstructed the army.</i>
redesign	The action or process of redesigning something. <i>It was achieved by the redesign of the product.</i>

remodel	Cast or model anew. <i>The station was remodelled and enlarged in 1927.</i>
reshape	Shape again or shape differently. <i>The new foreign minister reshaped the foreign policy of his country.</i>
<u>schematic</u>	In technical contexts a schematic diagram in particular of an electric or electronic circuit. <i>Only a few manufacturers provide schematics with their gear.</i>
sculptor	An artist who creates sculptures.
silversmith	Someone who makes or repairs articles of silver.
smith	Someone who works at something specified. <i>Tin bronze was cast into ingots before being smithed into bracelets.</i>
tanner	A lotion or cream designed to promote the development of a suntan or produce a similar skin colour artificially. <i>Skincare companies are coming to the rescue of consumers with sunless tanners.</i>
wright	Influential United States architect (1869-1959).
